never tear us apart

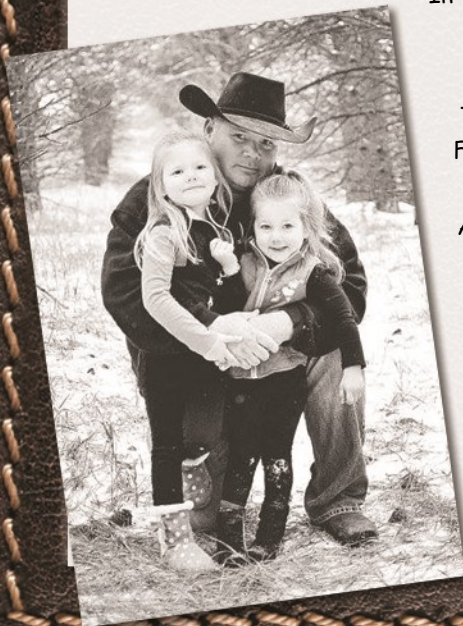
So we've come to say,
