Let us thank God.

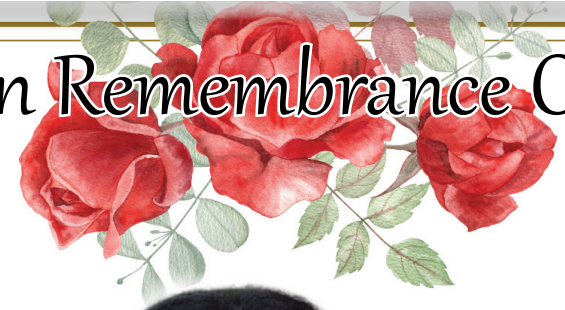
If you have to cry,
