we could not make you stay.

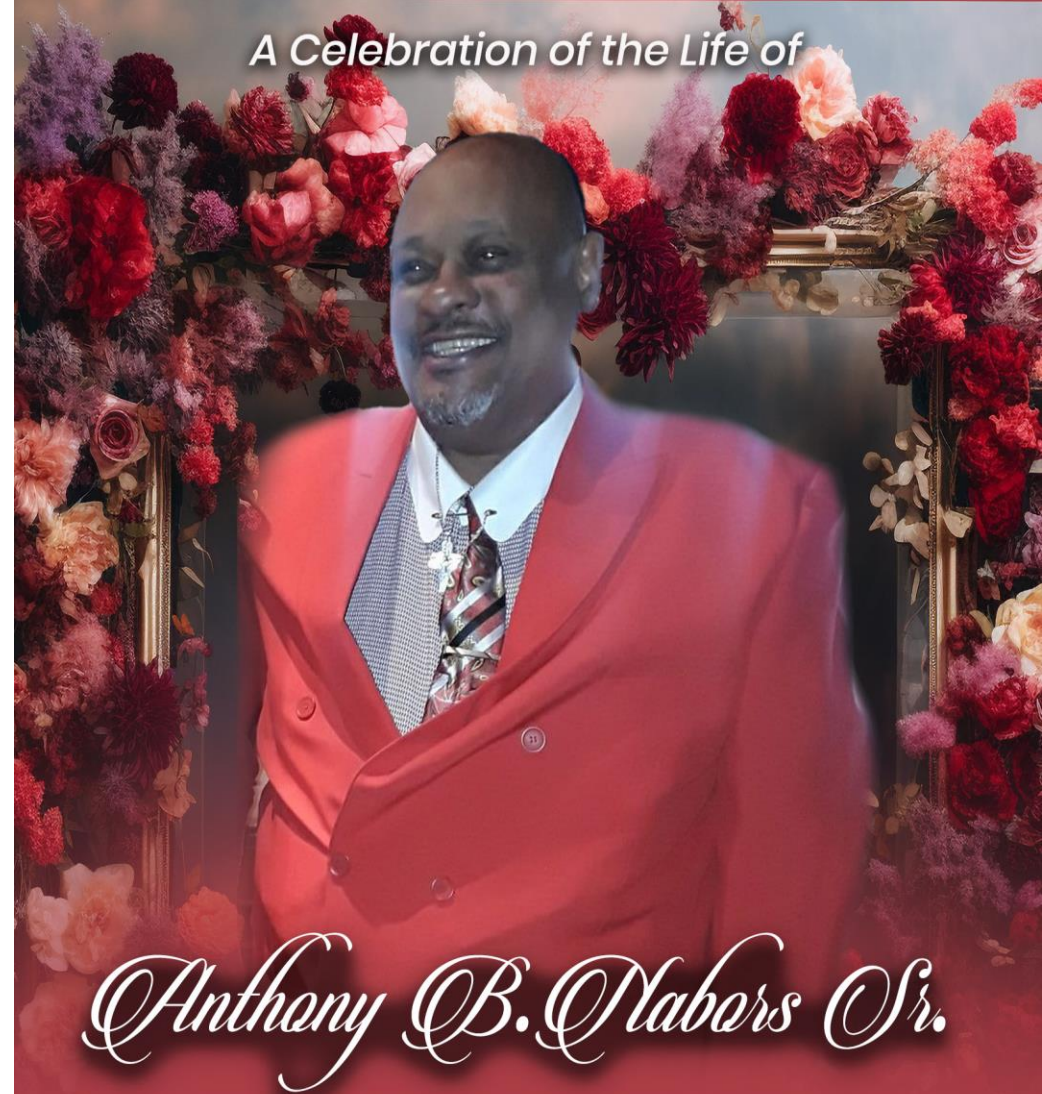
