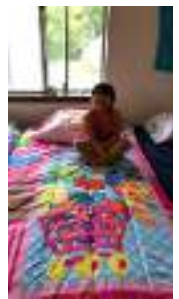
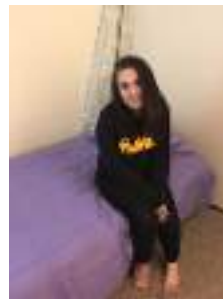
It was a beautiful black tie event, including assigned seating. We shared a table with school teachers who now know all about our program!

CHANGES TO OUR PROGRAM

We have discontinued the following parts of our program: **1) We will no longer be offering cribs.** Infants that need a crib are referred to the Marathon County Start Right Program, where they receive a free pack and play for the child to use through 1 year of age; **2) We will no longer be offering bunk beds.** We will only be offering twin size beds; and, **3) We will no longer be offering pajama's.** There are many services in our community that offer assistance with clothing needs, so we are going to refer any clothing requests to one of those organizations. **We will continue to offer complete sets of twin size beds, including a pillow and bedding.**
