Here are some reminders and information for 2018-19 school year.

Biggest Change is On Line Registration and Enrollment.

Please register and enroll as soon as possible. Several of our classes are very full and will have to be capped very soon.

Please visit our website, ASHEVILLEPISGAH.ORG , and enroll today.

For the 2018/2019 school year, every one will be required to complete our an online application/enrollment and pay \$25(non-refundable application fee). You can access the application on the APCS website under the "Admissions" tab.

Once your application is accepted, you will receive a link to the enrollment site. Here you will complete the enrollment forms.

This is a new process for all of us. Please call if you get stuck.

★ **Registration, enrollment and financial arrangements must be done prior to Open House.**

Open House (formerly called Registration)

Open house will be the principal's introduction of the 2018-19 school year at 5:30pm in the multi-purpose room followed with classroom/teacher visits at 6:00pm and 6:30pm in each classroom.

REMINDER FROM APCS BUSINESS OFFICE

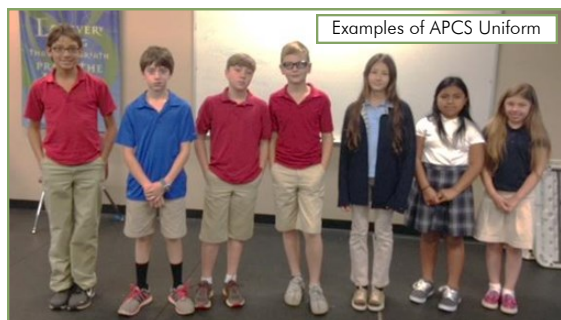


Dress Code

DRESS CODE

Please read through dress code carefully – Here are the highlights:

- ➔ **NEW!** PreK and K students must wear Velcro tennis type shoes that stay on feet and can be removed and put on by the student.
- ➔ Solid colored tights to be worn under dresses.
- ➔ Black, Navy or Khaki bottoms with solid color tops.
- ➔ Modest clothes – Shorts and skirts must be to the knee. No leggings.
- ➔ Sweaters and sweatshirts worn inside must be solid color.
- ➔ On Fridays students are invited to wear APCS sponsored t-shirts (IE APCS spirit wear) with uniform pants or skirts. Spirit wear will be on sale at the beginning of school.
- ➔ On Spirit Days students are invited to wear jeans with their Spirit Day outfits.



Cell phones

Cell phones, though a wonderful communication tool, have become a growing problem of distraction, unsupervised activities and hindrance to focus at school. **Cell phones are not allowed in the classrooms.**

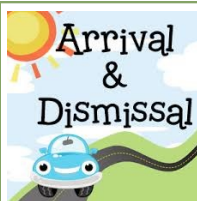
