

Day 1: Rabbits

Bible

- Family devotions and prayer time
- Read the story of creation in *Genesis* and find out which day God made rabbits.
- Watch a Bible video
- Listen to worship songs
- Read a Bible book with your family

- Rabbits hop. Make a list (kindergarten write, PreK say) of 4 or more words that rhyme with *hop*.
- Practice saying or singing the alphabet
- Practice writing your name or (PreK) the first letter of your name.

Day 2: Plants

Bible

- Family devotions and prayer time
- Read the story of creation in *Genesis* and find out which day God made the plants.
- Watch a Bible video

- Reading log (read at least 15 minutes with a caregiver)

- Discuss the story about planting a rainbow. Does that sound fun to you? Have you ever planted something with a family member? Where would you have to go to get plants and seeds for your garden or flower beds?
- Be part of helping your family by completing a chore/chores given to you by your grown-ups.

- Look for plants in & around your house. Count the different plants you see.

Language

- See if you can remember some of the flower names. Say the names and clap the syllables. How many does each flower have?
- Practice saying or singing the alphabet
- Practice writing your name or (PreK) the first letter of your name.

Day 3: Animal Babies

Bible

- Family devotions and prayer time
- Read a story in the Bible about moms and babies: For example, Isaac and Sarah, Hannah and Samuel, Mary and Jesus.
- Watch a Bible video
- Listen to worship songs
- Read a Bible book with your family

- Reading log (read at least 15 minutes with a caregiver)

Social Studies

- Name some mamas and babies in the story. How do the animal mamas help their babies? Why do you think God put kids in families with parents?
- Be part of helping your family by completing a chore/chores given to you by your grown-ups.

Math

- A mama and her baby make two. Practice counting by twos. See how high you can count.

Language

- Say a word that rhymes with each of these animal words; bat, cow, pup, llama, swan, calf, seal.
- Practice saying or singing the alphabet
- Practice writing your name or (PreK) the first letter of your name.

- Find a fun exercise video to do inside if the weather is bad.

Day 4: The Moon

Bible

- Family devotions and prayer time
- Find out from *Genesis* on which day God created the moon. What other things were created that day?
- Watch a Bible video
- Listen to worship songs
- Read a Bible book with your family
