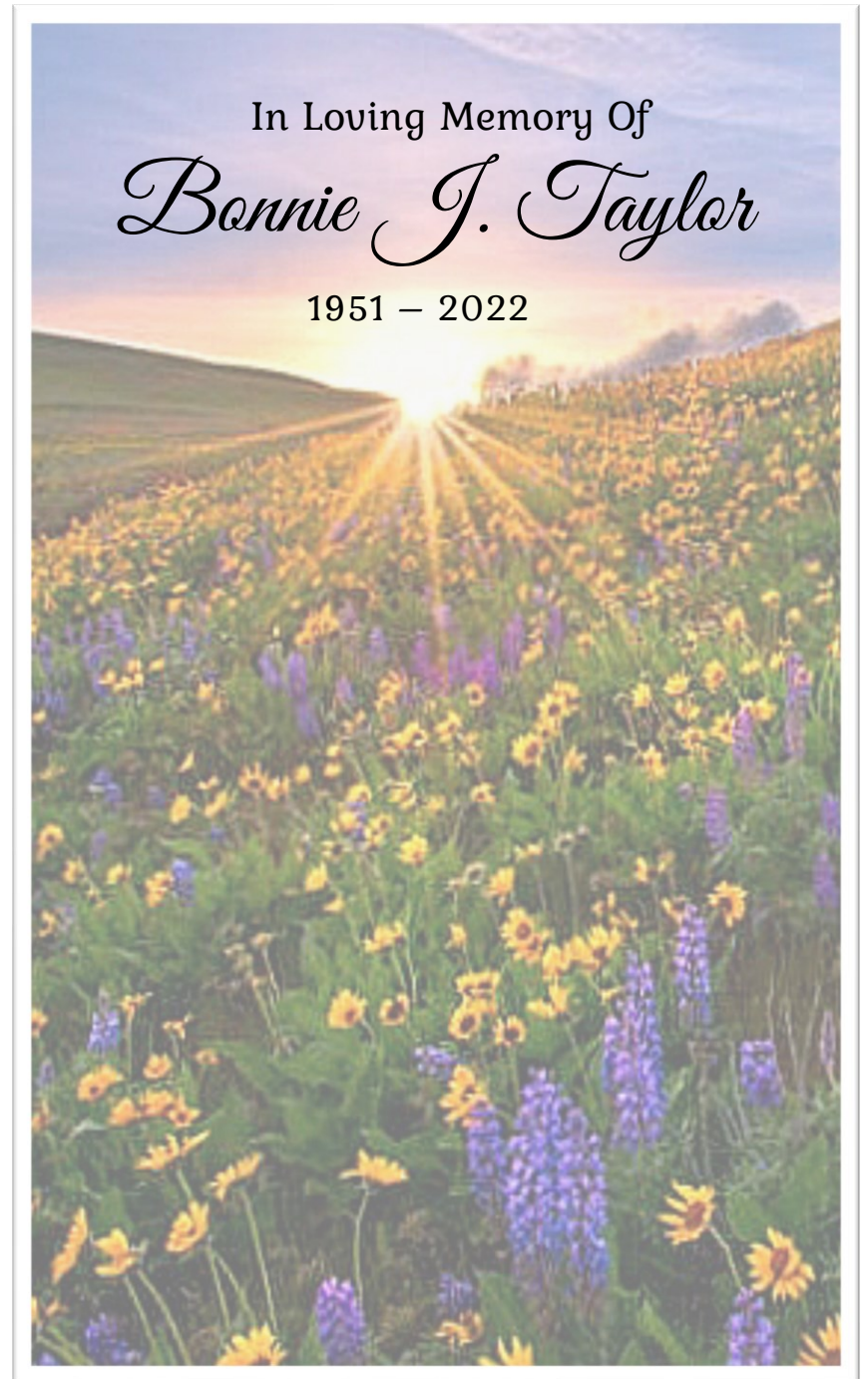


GOD looked around the garden,
