- Currently, our budget is \$6,500/month but we've only been receiving \$5,500/month. If this monthly short fall continues we'll have to lower our budget down \$1,000/month at our August 14 Church Business Meeting. This means ministries may not be funded the way we planned.
- Because of this shortfall we have a negative amount in our Church Budget account of \$9,800 that needs to be repaid.
