Class Level: Voyagers

Normally taught at camp:

1. Nature Study

- a. Review the story of Nicodemus and relate it to the life cycle of the butterfly, OR draw a life cycle chart of the caterpillar giving the spiritual significances.

3. Making Friends

- a. Discuss the needs, plan and participate in an activity for physically challenged individuals.

4. Nature Honor

- a. Voyagers will be fulfilling part of the Edible Wild Plants honor, but if you desire to complete the honor, you are responsible to complete it in its entirety at some later time.
- b. Identify, prepare and eat 10 varieties of edible wild plants. This replaces the Nature Study #2 requirement(s).

5. Fire Building + Camp Cookery

- #1. Lay five different kinds of fires and know their uses. Two of these fires must be cooking fires.
- #2. Safely make wood shavings or fuzz sticks.
- #3. Show correct techniques for starting a fire.
- #4. Start a fire with one match and keep it going for at least ten minutes.
- #5. Know and practice fire safety rules.
- #6. Show how to correctly and safely cut and split firewood.
