Allow me to tell you of Leroy Kevin Aldana. On September 19th, of 1982, in the Cayo District, the Western region of Belize, a bouncing, healthy baby boy entered into this world. He was the first child born to his loving parents Grace Aldana nee Hyde and Natividad Aldana, the newlyweds/the young family, named their baby boy Leroy Kevin Aldana.

Leroy completed some of his elementary education in Belize. In 1995, he migrated to the USA where he continued his education in Los Angeles, California.

As a young man, Leroy spent some time with his Dad in Texas and there he met Jessica Peterson, the mother of his two older children, Alexandria & Laron. Leroy was involved in a serious car accident while living in Texas. He received massive head injury and almost lost his left hand, hence the visible scars and his battle since with seizures. Leroy could no longer work at the capacity he was used to. That had a huge impact on his life for he wanted nothing more than to provide for his children. With this drastic change in his life, he decided to leave Texas and return to California to reside with his mom.

In Los Angeles, Leroy met Quianna Ramos and in March 2005 they got married. Their marriage lasted about 2 years.

Sometime later, Leroy met Angela Jones and together they conceived Aniyala, his third child and baby girl.

Leroy's passion was for auto mechanic & repairs and he enjoyed doing so. He was also just very good with his hands, and did work as a handy man. But Unfortunately, after the accident, he faced difficulties holding jobs due to health and physical ailments brought on by the accident. That accident really changed his life.

Besides this passion, whomever knew him knows that he had a love for music and dancing; dancing to his own beats too, he loved rapping and singing. Lee was a highlight at every party. He was very jovial, fun and loving.

One thing for sure, his family, we all knew you cannot offer him food without also handing him the Barbeque sauce. You may think it would ruin the flavor of the food, but for Lee, everything goes better with barbeque sauce, even soup was better with BBQ Sauce.

Leroy lived in Los Angeles for most of his life until he moved to Las Vegas with his Mom, brother, sister-in-law Jeanette and nephew KJ. These two brothers; Kenroy and Leroy's relationship was very close and got even closer here in Las Vegas, after all, all they had was each other.

Leroy endured 13 difficult years facing seizures. During these last couple of years battling with this ailment, he voiced his concern about not being here for much longer. He felt his last days coming and started spending as much time as he can with his family and friends. Leroy was a really giving person, we are all human beings and we make mistakes, as Leroy did also, but he loved with all his heart. Most of his seizures occurred at home until this very last one; where he was hanging out with his friends who witnessed the seizure and made the 911 call at 3pm. He fought a good fight but his heart grew tired and gave out at 4:06pm on June 30th 2022. We miss you dearly Leroy, but God loved you best.

Leroy/Lee/ Kevin, was survived by, His parents, Grace Hyde and Natividad Aldana. His Children, Alexandria, Laron, and Aniyala Aldana. His Sister, Eden Bluntt. His Brothers, Kenroy Natividad, Jesus Natividad Jr., Sheldon, Kenneth, Ivan and Jared. Nieces, Zorah & Amaris Bluntt, & Carla Charley. Nephews, Kenroy Natividad Aldana (KJ) and Ahijah Charley. His Grand Dad, Gilbert Hyde and a host of Aunts, Uncles, relatives and friends

He was predeceased by his baby brother, Marlon (Marloncito) Aldana, his Grandmothers Ruperta Patt and Selcia Humes, his Grandfather Roy Aldana, and sister, Ingrid Charley.

In closing, if Lee/Kevin was here today, he would say, in his own words:

“Don't let nobody steal your joy.
Another quedo, love you in the morning.
Bless those who have it and those who don't.
You got a dollar? “
And finally,
“don't throw it away, I'll eat it”

Especially with barbeque sauce.

Rest in peace Leroy Kevin, and rise in glory, you were loved and you are already missed dearly

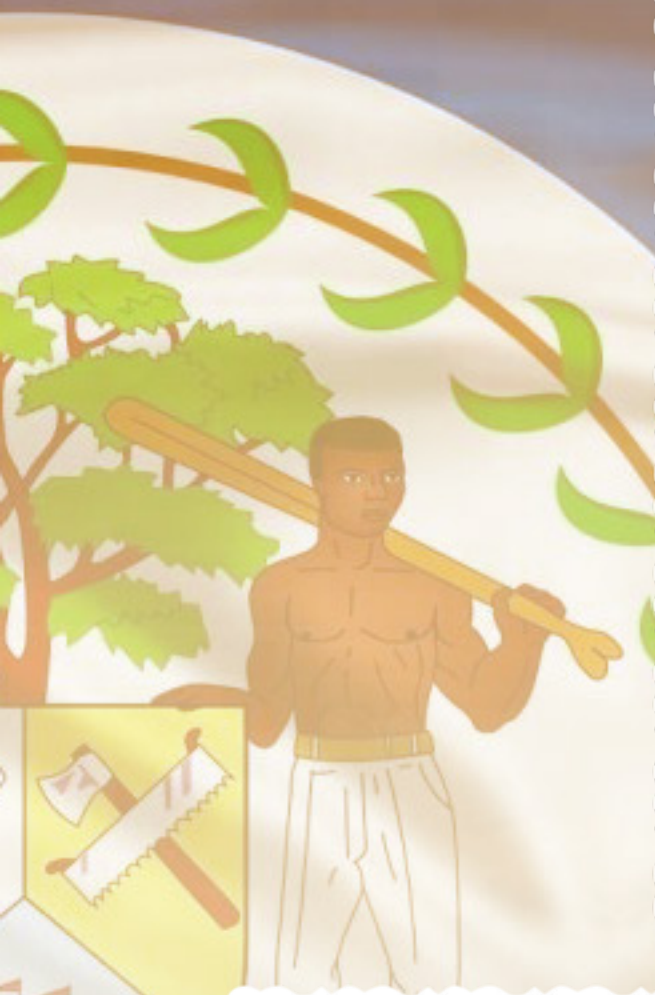
