3.0 **NOTICE OF MEETING**

The Director General read the notice of the meeting and confirmed that it was issued in accordance with the provisions of the Law.

4.0 **ADOPTION OF AGENDA**

The Director General read out the Agenda for the 2017 Annual General Meeting. The motion for amendment of the Agenda to include presentation on the Institute's Victoria Island Building was moved by Mr. Adeyemo Adejumo (A&E Integrated Services) and supported by Mrs. Seyi Ifaturoti (Crystal Project Management & Claims).

5.0 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

5.1 Adoption of the Minutes of the 2016 Annual General Meeting

The minutes of the Institute's 2016 Annual General Meeting which was held on Wednesday 13th July, 2016 at The Transcorp Hilton Hotel, Abuja were taken as read and subsequently adopted based on a motion moved by Mrs. Yetunde Ilori (Axa Mansard Insurance Plc) and seconded by Mr. Teju Ogunjimi (Smoothway Insurance Brokers).

Members in their contributions commended the growth noticed in the report. It was however suggested that the assets of the Institute should be revalued.

The Report of the financial year ended 31st December, 2016 and the Auditor's Report were adopted following the motion moved by Mr. Kunle Ahmed (Axa Mansard Insurance Plc) and Mr. Shola Ajibade (Continental Reinsurance Plc).

8.0 APPOINTMENT OF AUDITORS
