On May 13th, after having his breakfast and daily chat with Mom, Brice complained of back pain and went to lay down. He wasn't able to get comfortable, so one of the nurses suggested he sit in his chair before getting his meds. When she returned, he was "peacefully" asleep in the chair (no more meds or pain).

Brice loved his name and being a Watson. He loved his family, friends, women, \$1 bets, sports talk, parties, gardening, sending cards, gossip and a good church service. He was baptized at Salem Baptist Church, he later attended Grace Apostolic Church and other churches that would pick him up for service. He graduated from North High School in 1983, and went to Job Corp. Later he moved to Colorado Springs, CO with his cousins Vincent Dale Watson & Debbie Brooks. He lived the best years of his life there. Brice enjoyed going to the family home and hanging out with Dad and going to Kina's to garden with her. But most of all he enjoyed going for rides with his cousins. Never sharing where they went.
