## Scholastic Book Fair

The Scholastic Book Fair is coming soon. Mark your calendars for April 12 – 17 and plan to visit our BOGO book fair.

Optional: One exciting new option this year is the eWallet for students. Parents can participate in this new digital payment option. Create an account for your student and set a spending limit. Students can use their eWallet to shop the in-school book fair and you won't need to worry that they might lose their money. Once the fair ends, any unused funds are released back to the credit card on file. There is no fee for creating an eWallet. It is a free service for our school community. Parents must create an eWallet for each student; accounts cannot be shared or transferred. There is a minimum of \$10.00 in order to set up an account, but no maximum. Parents will only be charged for what is purchased at the fair up to the spending limit they have selected. You can add funds to the eWallet at any time. Extended family members who are unable to attend the book fair and want to support your student can also set up an eWallet for your student and he or she will have multiple eWallets to spend.
