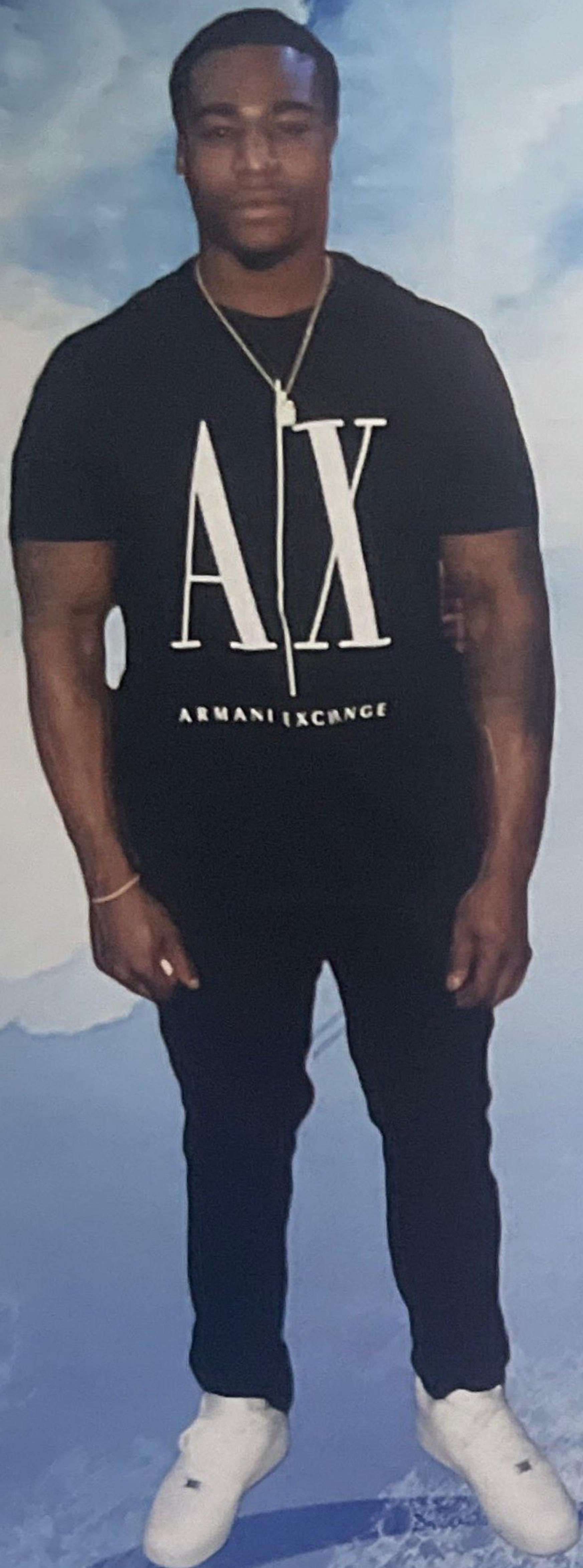

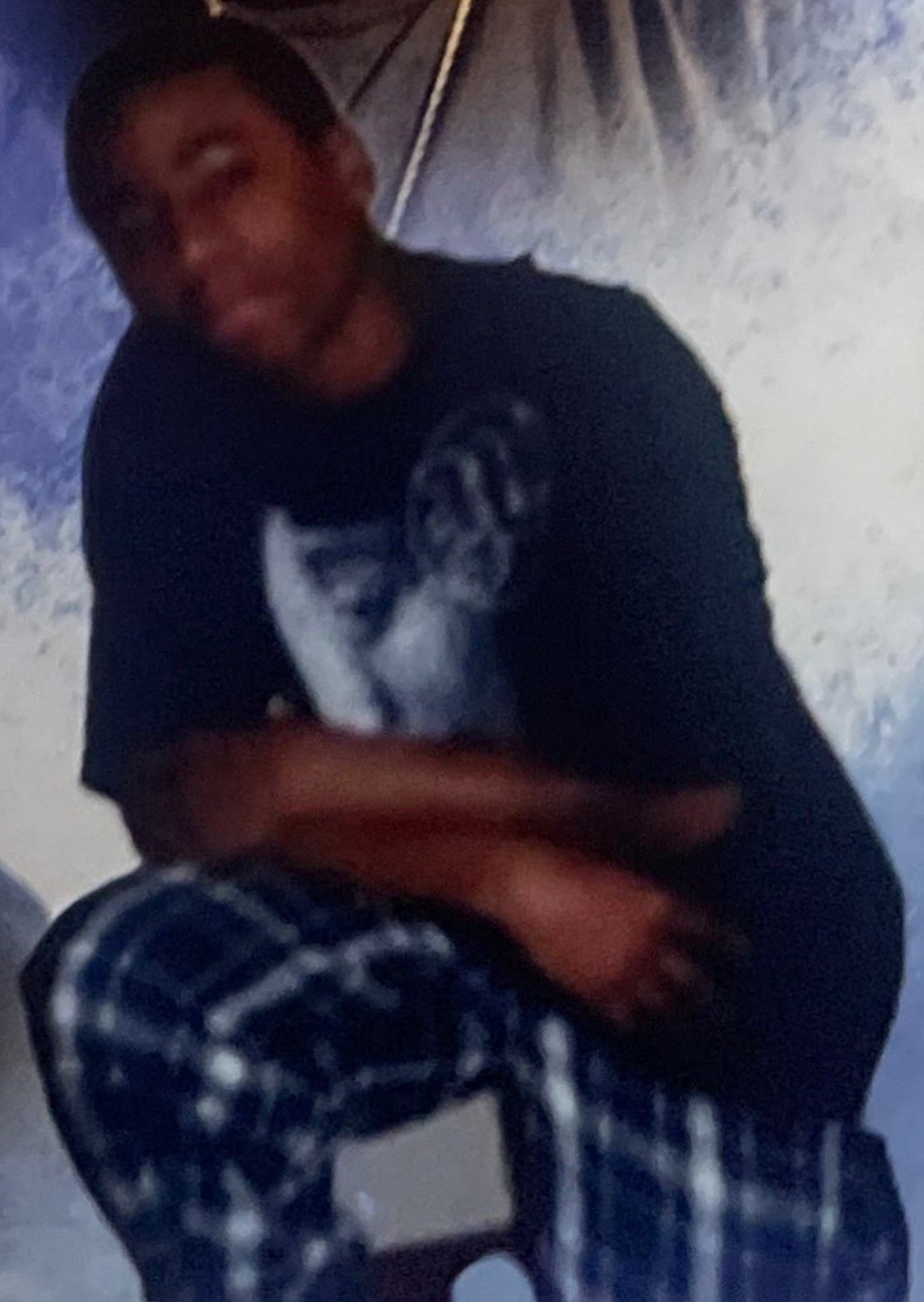
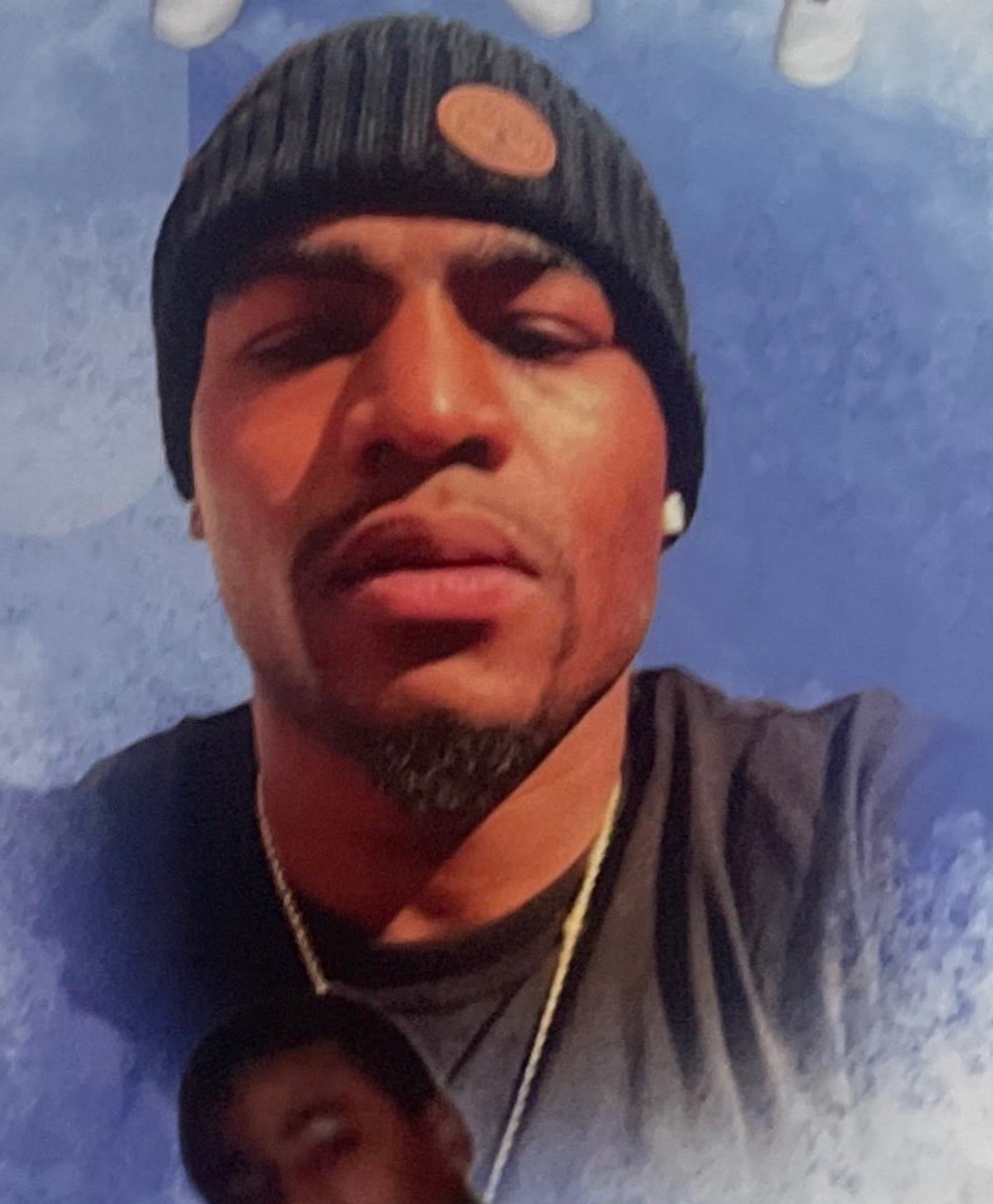
To My Family & Friends

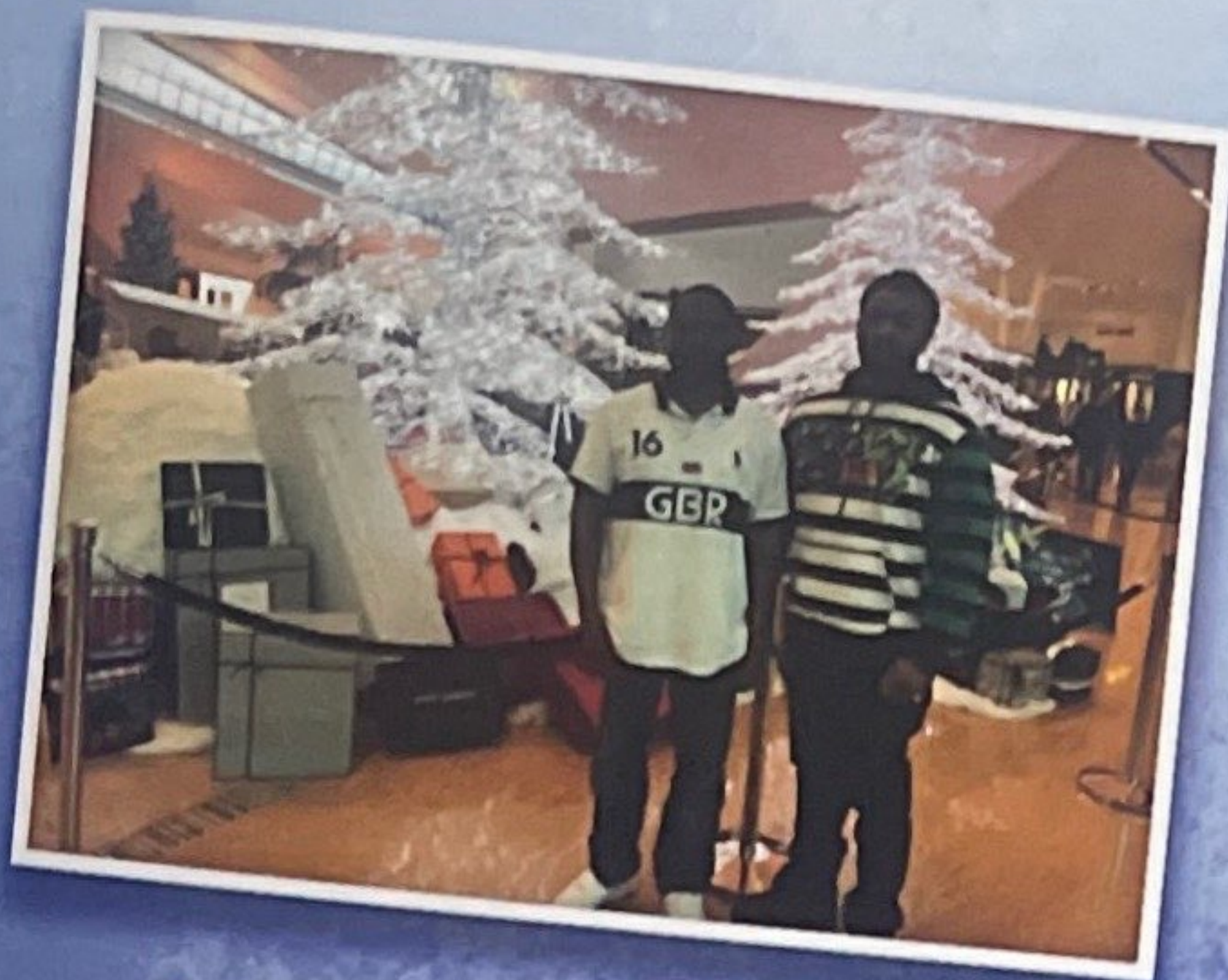
To My Son

From heaven you was delivered as a baby unto me. God trusted that I will do everything that is needed to nurture you and to love you.

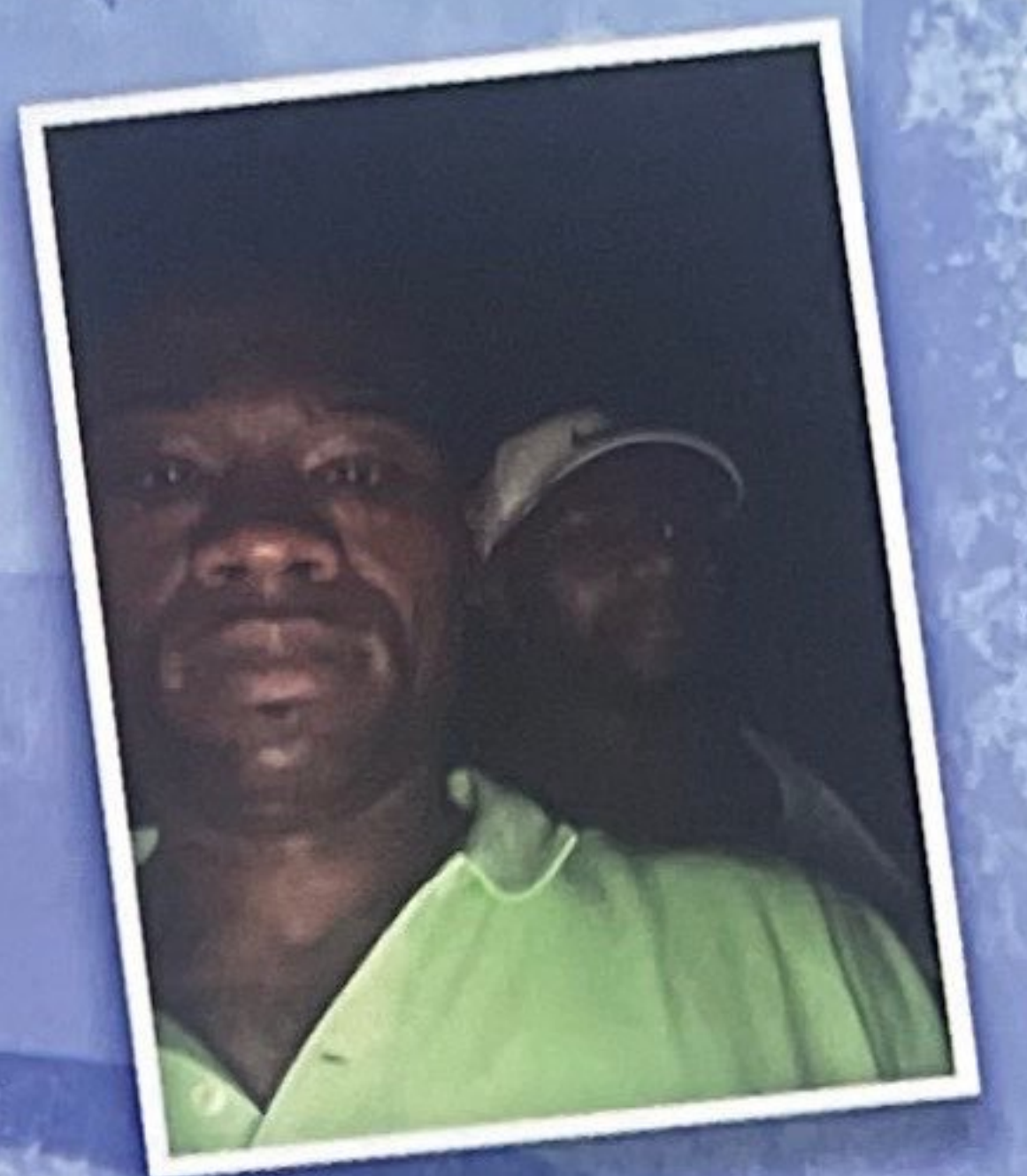
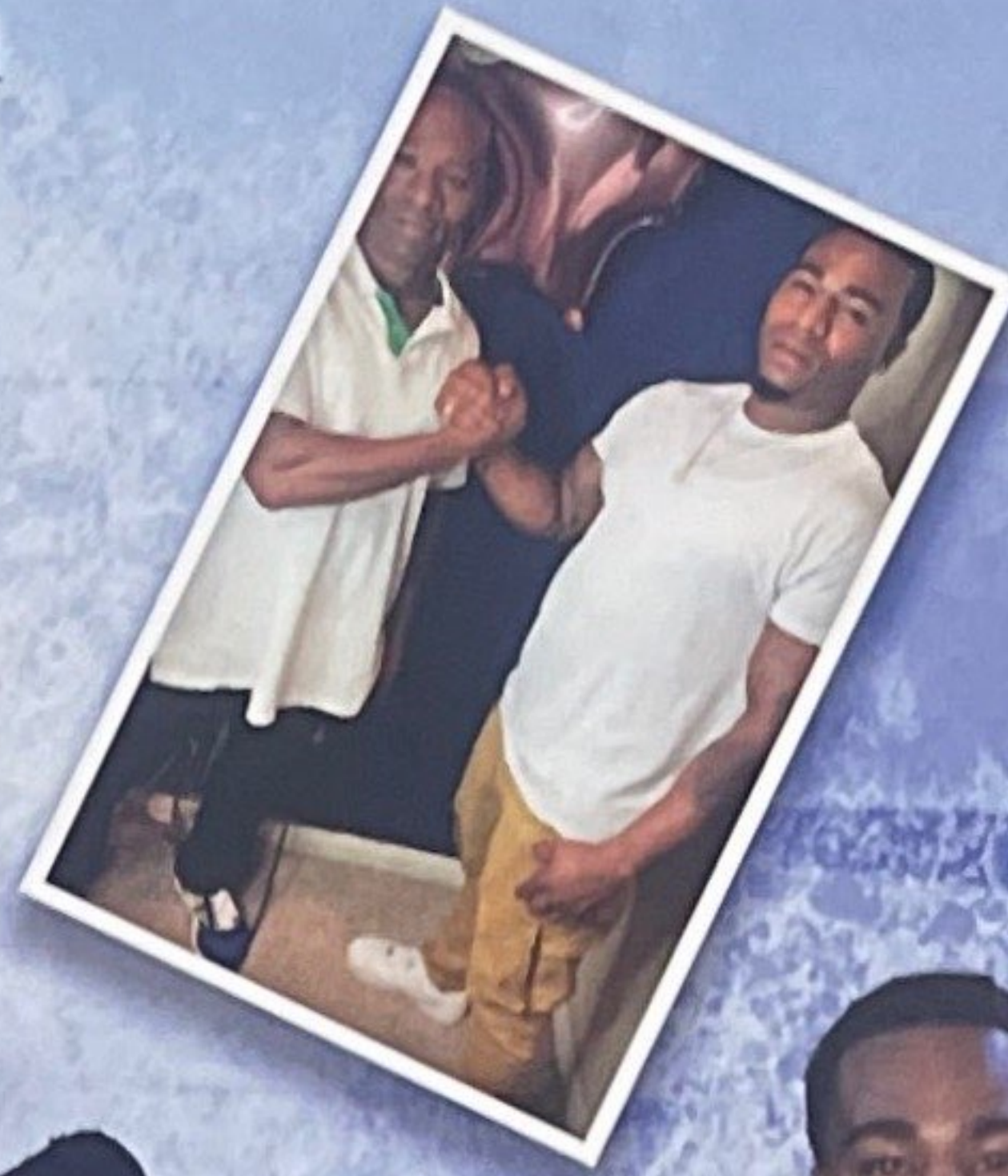

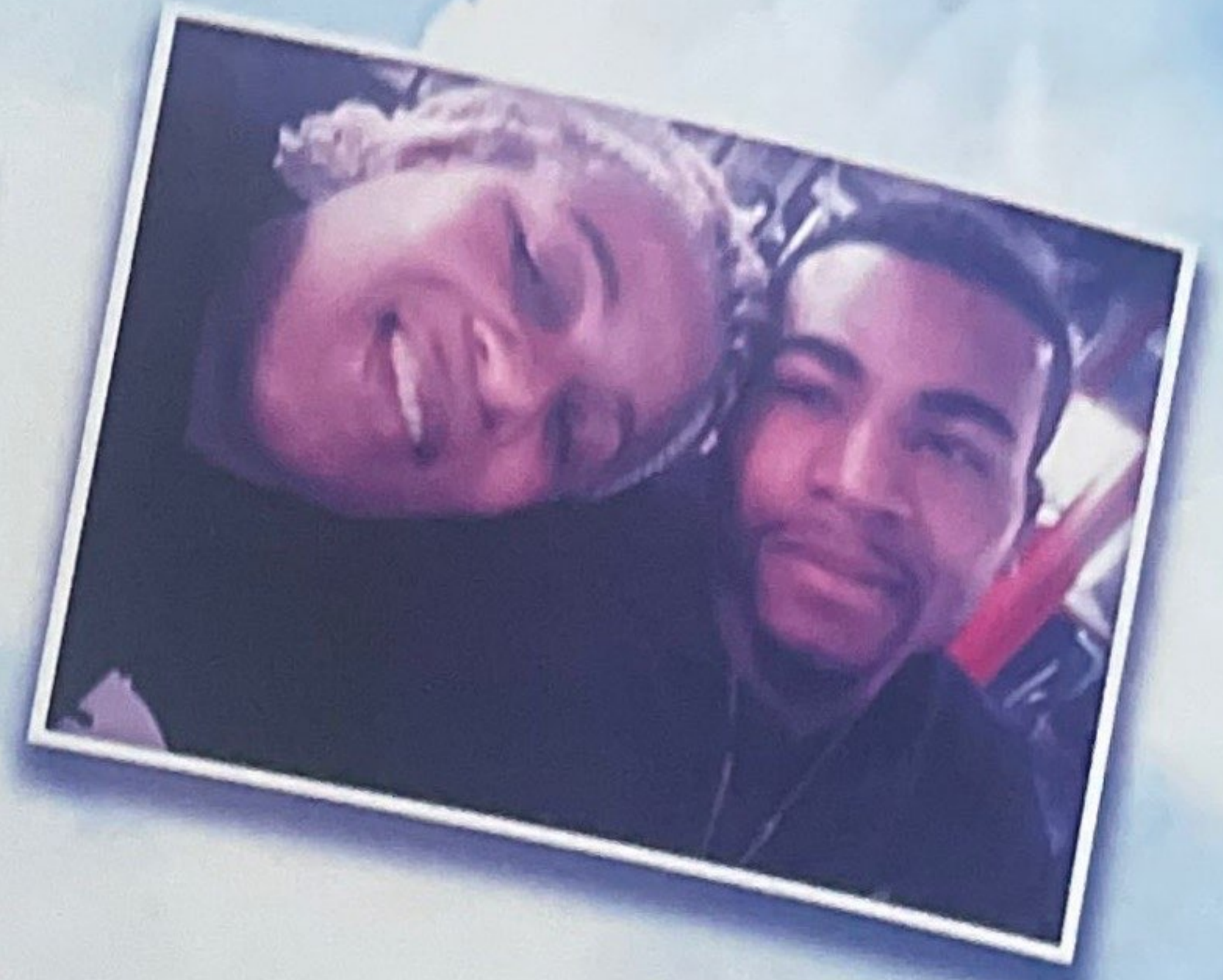


Tributes
