- † Sentence diagramming to find the primary meaning of 1st angel's message
- † Common thread: A warning against self-worship or self-dependence and an invitation to the deeper life of faith, especially in the time of judgment.
- † Few (including ministers) understand the 3rd angel's message –*Manuscript 15, 1888; Review & Herald 12-11-1888; Evangelism, p. 196*
- † Statements regarding justification by faith –*Review & Herald 4-1-1890; 9-3-1889*
- † Definition for justification by faith –*Testimonies to Ministers, p. 456*
- † Nothing without Christ (**John 15:5**), all things with Him (**Philippians 4:13**)
- † To "fear God" is to hold Him in awe
- † "Give glory to Him" doesn't exist outside of a personal relationship with Christ
- † Giants of faith direct glory to God –**Romans 4:20**
- † Examples of misdirected glory -**1 Corinthians 5:6; Galatians 6:14**
- † "Worship Him" is impossible when living self-dependently
- † Wisdom, strength, and riches don't compare to knowing Jesus –**Jeremiah 9:23-24**
