Dress Code Reminders

We're off to a great start for our new school year; however, we have had many dress code violations in our first few weeks. Please remember that holes in pants are not allowed, even when done on purpose. An easy fix is to use patches to cover holes. Pants also need to be loose-fitting. Leggings can only be worn with a top that is nearly knee-length. Please keep in mind that shorts may be worn at school, but they must be nearly knee-length. Shirts must have sleeves (no tank tops) and cover the midriff at all times, even when arms are raised. Flip flops are not to be worn at school as they do not provide protection for feet during PE and recess. Jewelry is not allowed at any time.
