

Pray for Afghanistan

The Taliban has taken control of Afghanistan in a ten-day advance following the withdrawal of US and other foreign troops in June and July. We have evacuated all BMS World Mission workers in Afghanistan from the country. Please continue to pray for our Afghan partner at this time, as we actively explore how we can respond and meet the needs of people in Afghanistan.
