Today I am praising God that I am cancer free.

2018 Summit on Abuse

"We will not bury our heads to act as if abuse does not happen," said Ivan Williams, director of the North American Division Ministerial Association during his opening remarks at the NAD enditnow Summit on Abuse's first day, September 24.



The two-day summit, held at the NAD headquarters in Columbia, Md., was organized to help equip pastors, teachers, volunteers, church staff, and members with the tools and knowledge to help end abuse within their scope of influence. As part of the Church's "enditnow" campaign, the summit featured a number of experts ranging from church leaders and administrators, advocates, attorneys, and women who shared their personal encounters with abuse.

"We have a God-ordained responsibility is to work to protect those vulnerable around us. So, our policies, our teachings, should be done in a way that will protect the most vulnerable among us, including the children, spouses, and persons in abusive relationships," said Bryant.


