We have you in my heart.

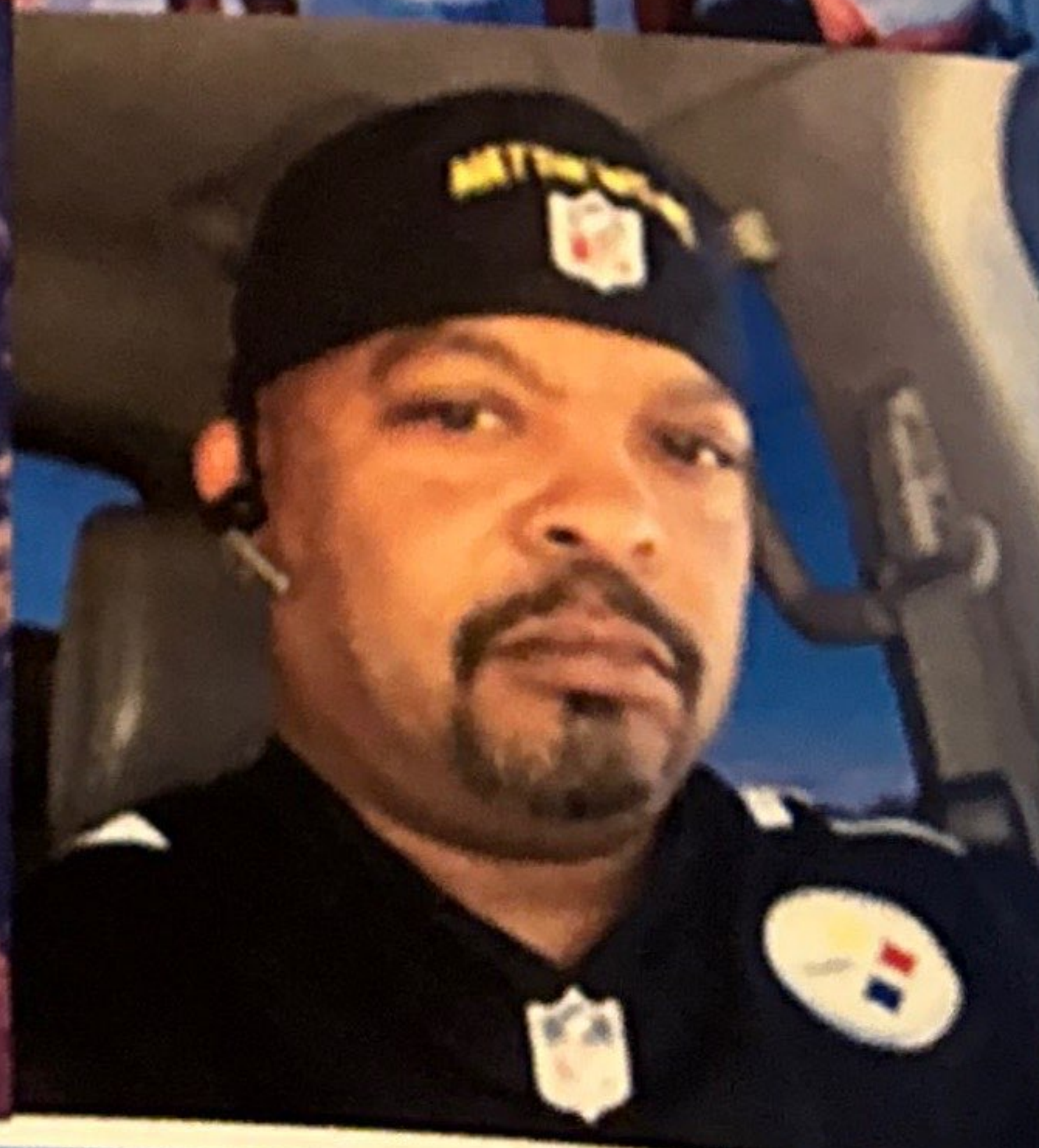
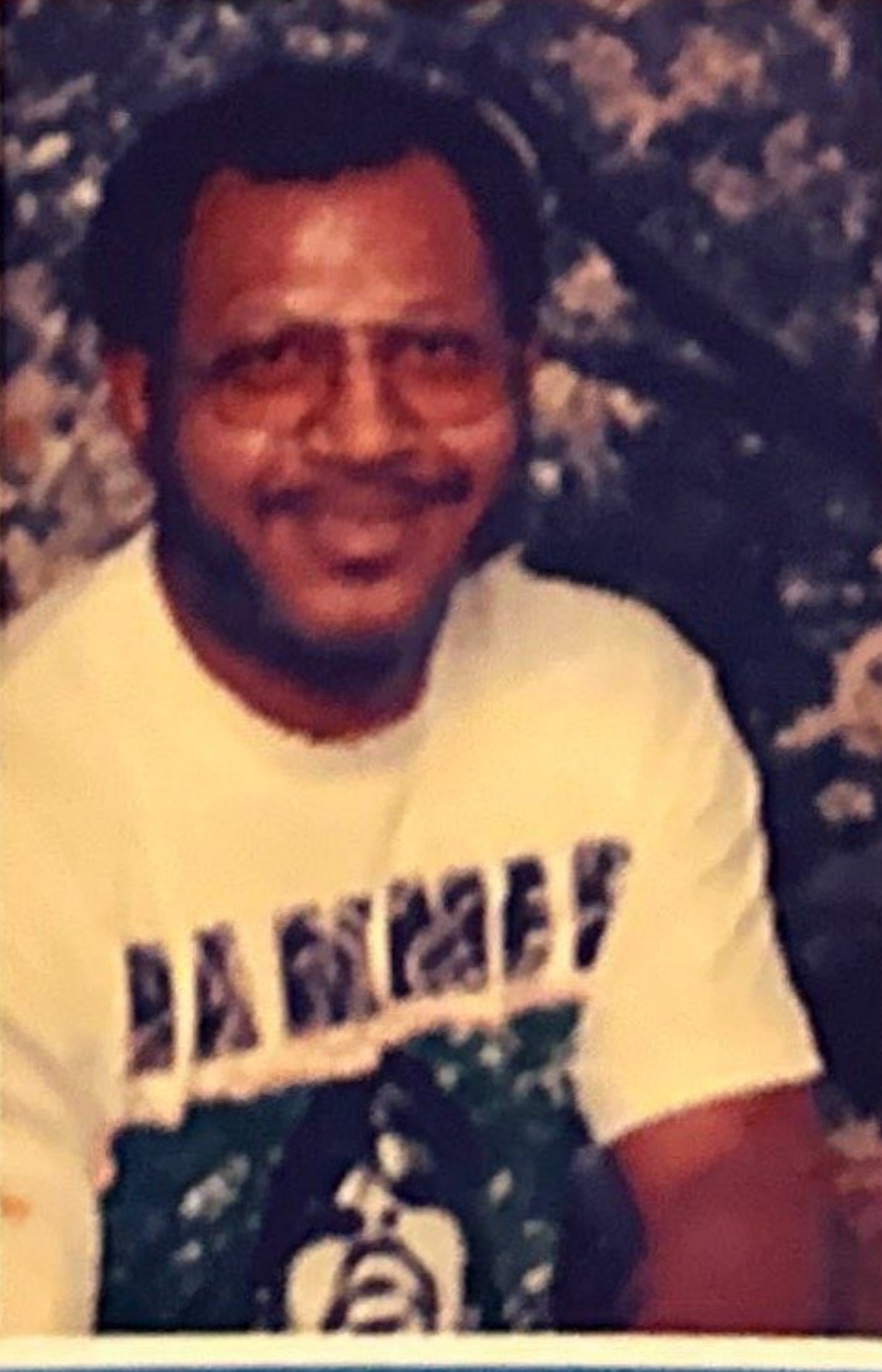
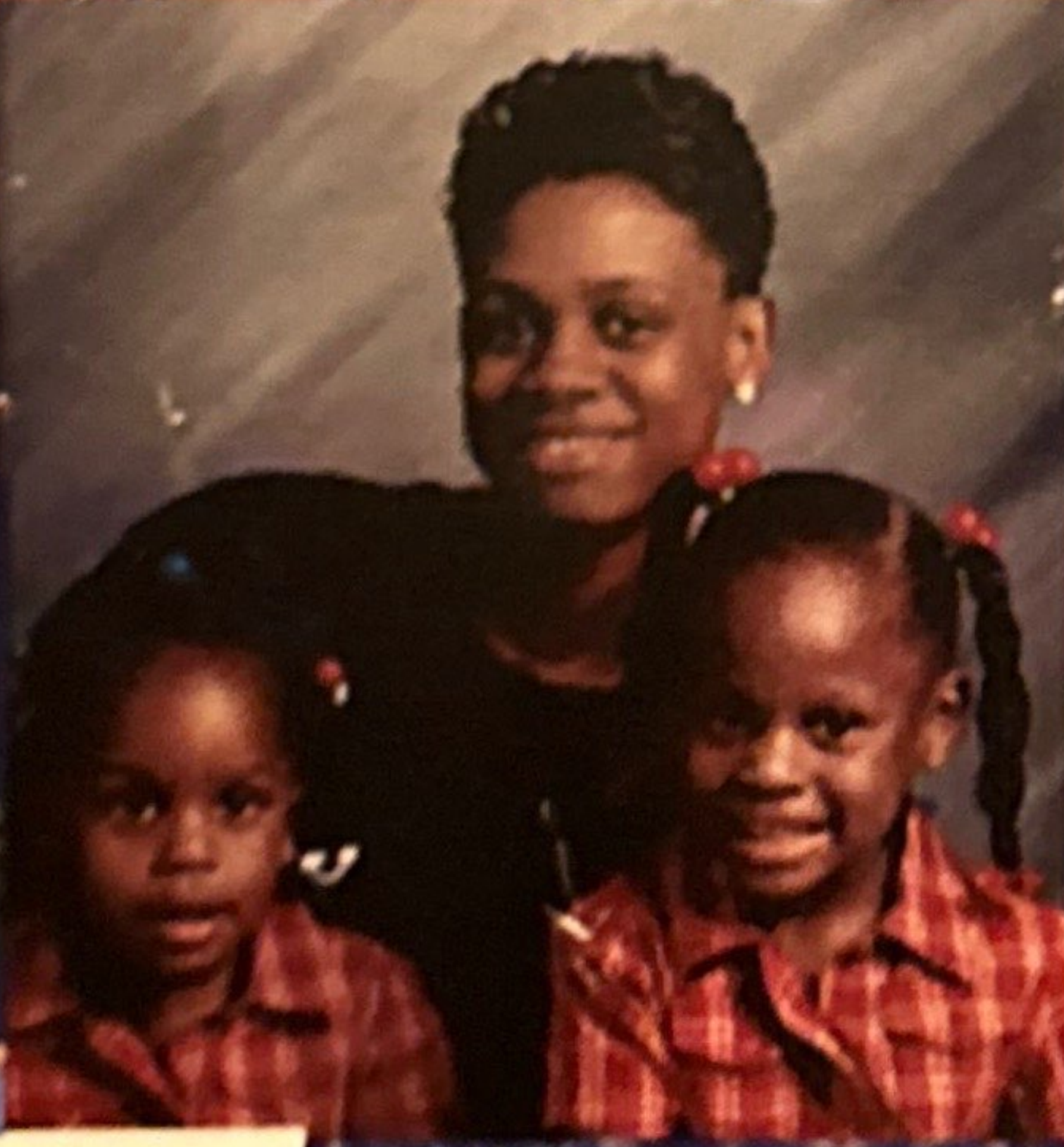
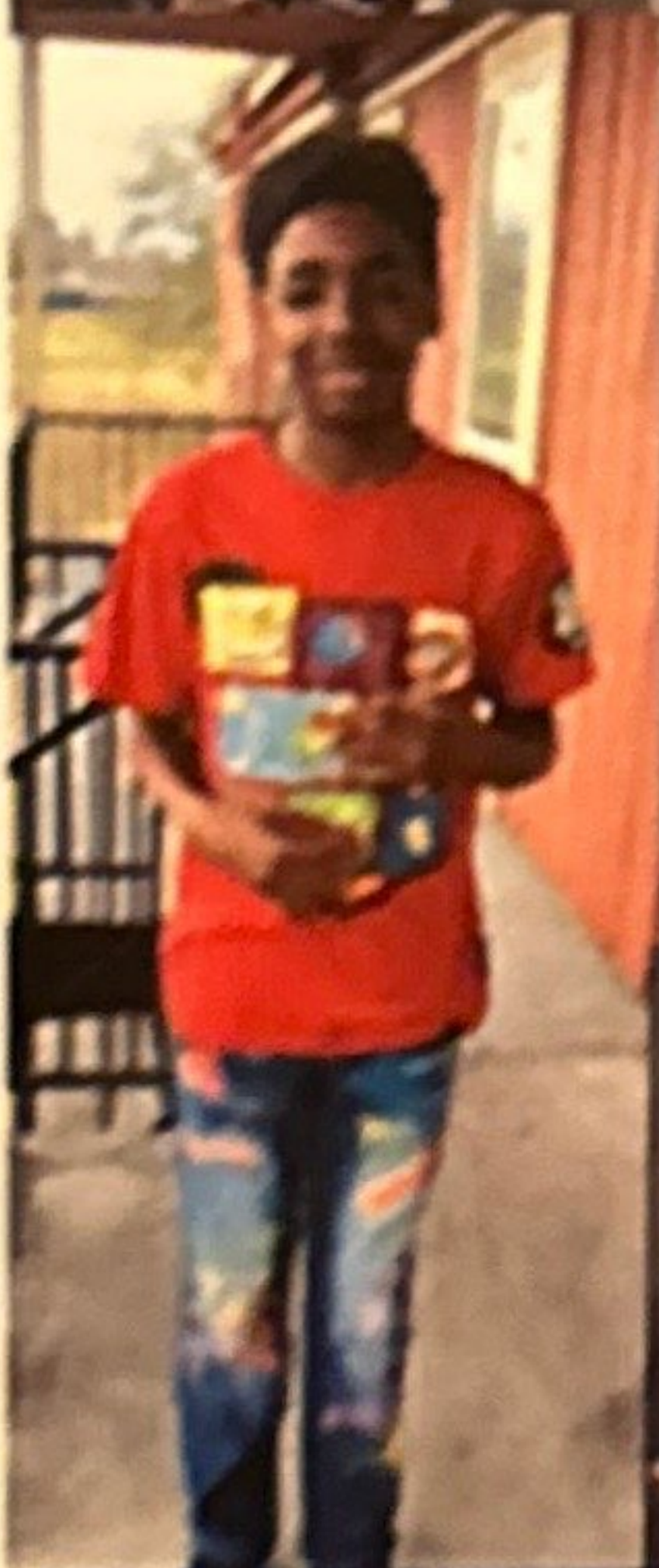
