LaVonne was united in marriage to Robert "Bob" Hildebrandt on September 10, 1949, at Gustavus Adolphus in St. Paul. The couple lived in St. Paul for three years before moving to Billings, Montana. The family moved back to Cottage Grove, Minnesota for a short time before moving to Alexandria in 1982.
