is striking and shows two people climbing to the summit of a mountain silhouetted by the bright glare of the sun. The image helps reinforce the message of the verse. It can be viewed in many ways and perhaps as the year progresses different aspects of the picture and bible verse will speak to you and your circumstances in new and fresh ways. I'd like to start by highlighting three images.



Firstly, the picture of the person at the summit reaching down and offering a hand to help the other person up. It's a picture of kindness – one person offering help to another. Secondly, the image of the two working together to reach the summit. It's a picture of encouragement and collaboration – working together towards a common goal. Thirdly, the image of the lower person stretching out their arm to be helped by the other person. It's a picture of reaching out and accepting the help of another.

All three images are highlighted by the bright glare of the sun shining through in the shape of the cross – illuminating all we do for the glory of God. Perhaps one, or all of these images speak to you and your situation as we embark on this new year of 2024. Are you in a position to help another, or are you cheering others on towards good works, or are you in need of the help of others? All of these images, and more besides, are a picture of what it means to be part of the church.


