### Responsibilities and Duties:

The Team Manager shall be responsible for:

- Consulting with the Senior Coach on all matters and specifically on any problems with team members.
- The athlete's physical, mental and emotional well-being whilst on tour.
- Ensuring that the athlete's meals/diet, sleeping habits and recreation are conducive to optimum tournament performance.
- Fostering team spirit to enable all athletes to participate and perform at their best.
- Providing a detailed report to the Development Manager within 10 working days of the completion of the tour.
- Liaising with the Development Manager and Senior Coach with regards to team administration, including organizing and distribution of team uniforms etc., airline tickets, accommodation, medical forms, athlete agreement forms and State Team Guidelines.
- Accompanying (or delegate appropriate qualified person) any team member who requires dental, medical or hospital attention, or drug testing.
- Attending AJC manager meetings and passing on any relevant information to the Senior Coach and team.
- Providing assistance and support to the Senior Coach.
- Adjudicating any off-court issues that may arise amongst the athletes, officials or supporters.
- Ensuring that the tour is a harmonious event with the combination of excellent team spirit, good health and the best environment for optimum performance.

**Qualifications, Skills, Experience**

- Demonstrated leadership and management experience and being able to ensure good organisation and communication with all members of the Squash SA State Junior Team.
- Good personal relationship skills and high-level communication skills.
- Understanding of the protocol and procedures required at the Australian Junior Squash Championships.
- Previous tour experience with a South Australian team preferred (not necessarily as Team Manager).
- Be an accredited coach (an advantage but not essential)
- Holder of a current Senior First Aid certification
- Be medically fit to attend the AJC and travel interstate.
- Be considered compatible with other team athletes and officials.

**Other Requirements**

- Holder of a current drivers licence.
- Attend all training / Sport Science / Sports Physiology sessions as determined by the Development Manager and Senior Coach.
- Undertake or hold a current DCSI working with children clearance.
- Comply with the SRASA Member Protection Policy in accordance with the current legislation.
