We will continue offering quality Adventist Christian Education to children for the 2019-2020 school year. Not only do we have a new (1-year-old) Bible Encounter program, we also have a phenomenal Language Arts program. The 1st – 8th Language Arts program, called Pathways 2.0, has been upgraded to include new reading titles and teacher editions. Kindergarteners will continue with the exceptional Stepping Stones curriculum. We also will continue to offer Social Studies/History and Science curriculum that reflects current trends while still viewed through a Creation-based lens.

In all subjects, as appropriate, technology will be incorporated. As an example, this year music students who studied different musical eras, created a presentation of their era using Animotica, pairing music with pictures and text.

For the 2019-2020 school year we are adding electrical and electronics segments to our STEM curriculum. We have a volunteer with years of experience in the electrical and semiconductor industries who will assist in teaching this class. We will continue to develop and expand our STEM curriculum.

In addition to our day-to-day academics, we will continue to offer participation in off-campus activities, allowing students the opportunity to travel to other areas of Texas to interact with students from other schools. For example, the Texas Conference provides an opportunity for students to participate in an annual Outdoor School for 5th & 6th graders, and a Music Festival for 7th & 8th graders. We will also look for opportunities to join other Houston area Adventist schools in a Book Fair, Science or Social Studies Fair, or a joint field trip to a Houston area educational sites (such as the Museum of Science and History, the Planetarium, and zoo). We will be looking for meaningful field trips that will encourage each child to explore and discover different fields of interest.

While there are changes in the staff, the commitment to providing quality education, safety, and emphasis on Christ to our student body is unchanged. We look forward to having you join our learning team and know that your support will enrich our program.
