

Worship Alert: The Church is God's house (1 Kings 9:3). The congregation is God's people (2 Chro 7:14). The Sabbath is God's time (Exo 20:10, 11; Rev 1:10). The messenger is God's voice (Numb 12:6-8). The message is God's Word (1 Sam 8:7 – come, let us worship God with glorification and praise (2 Chro 7:3).

Reverence
Reverence in the house of God, during and after a service, is an integral part of worship. Loud talking, unnecessary milling around, while a service is taking place, littering of the sanctuary, conducting conversations of a secular nature in His house desecrate the temple of God. "Humility and reverence should characterize the deportment of all who come into the presence of God." *Patriarchs & Prophets, p. 252.*

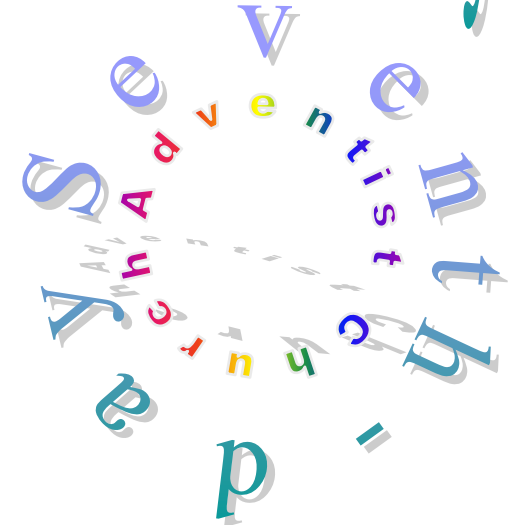
