He received his early education in the Philadelphia public school system; graduating from William Penn High School.

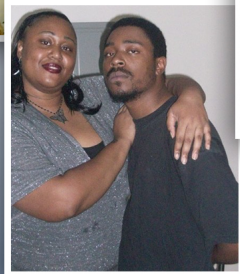
