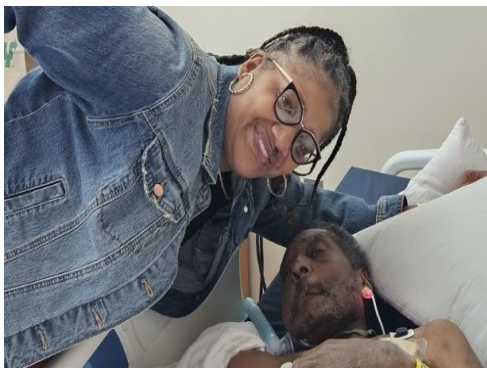


Poem To My Dad

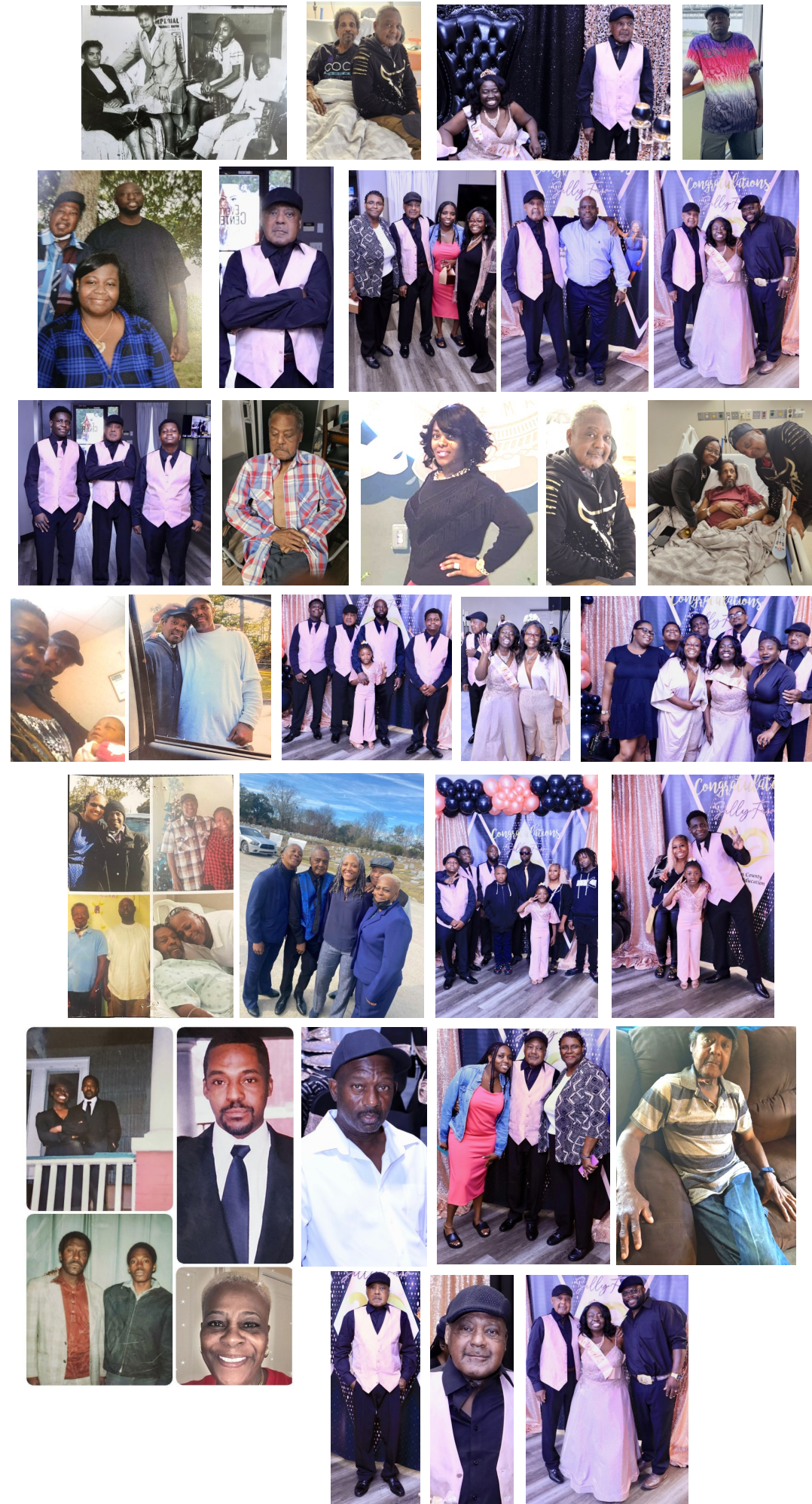
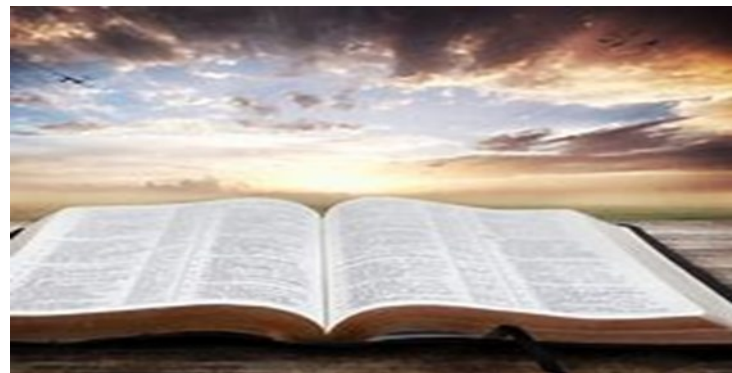
