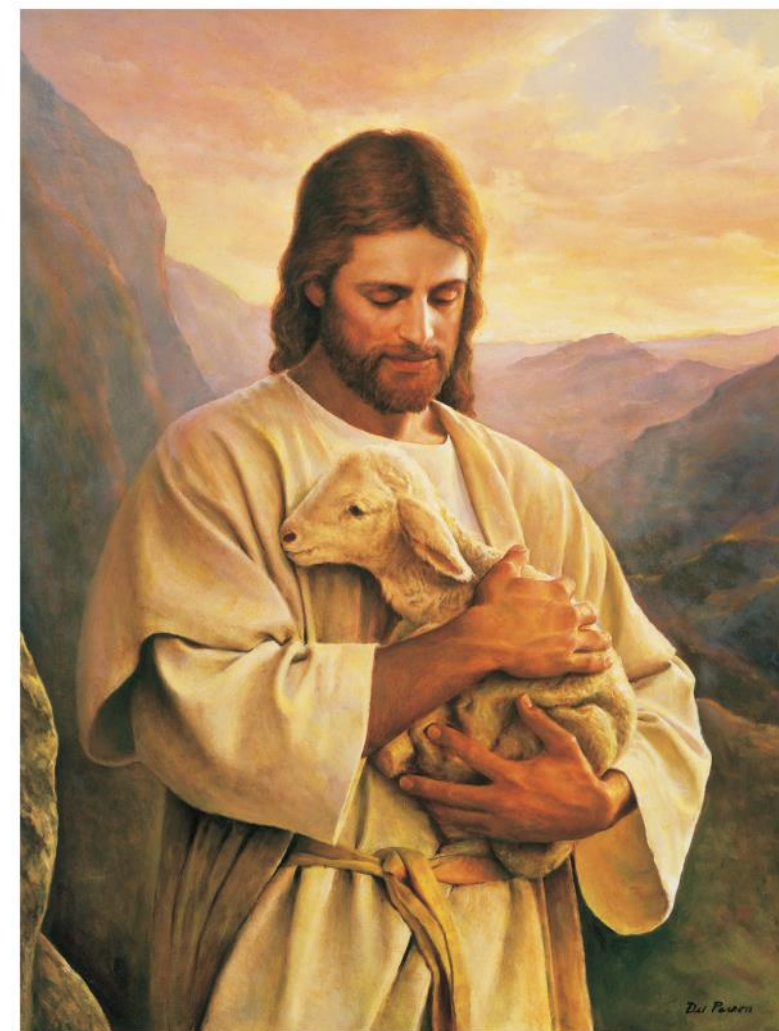

The scripture for today is **James 1:4**
