School Days: The 180 required school days shall consist of a minimum of five (5) hours of instructional time. Physical Education can be a part of the five (5) hours. Recess and lunch must be in addition to the five (5) hours. Friday school days must include five (5) instructional hours as well.

In essence, minimum school days are only allowed in accordance with the guidelines #16 and #21 in the "Instructional Days and Time Requirements Frequently Asked Questions" on the Indiana Department of Education website (www.doe.in.gov/accreditation). Please look for the link under "Instructional Time/180 Day Requirement" titled "FAQ Instructional Time."

Two half (½) days do not count as a school day.

Parent-Teacher Conferences: These do not count as school time. Parent-Teacher conferences must be in addition to required instructional time.

Indiana School Choice Scholarships: Schools participating in Indiana Choice Scholarship (vouchers) may be financially penalized by the state if the guidelines for minimal instructional time and days are not followed. (Refer to question #8 in the "Instructional Days and Time Requirements Frequently Asked Questions.")

National Holidays: Conference schools should not be in session on national holidays identified on this calendar unless public schools in their area are using those days as emergency snow make up days.

Recommended School Day Hours:

- 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The Indiana Conference Office of Education endeavors to coordinate a school system in which all locations follow the same calendar. Any deviations from this calendar must be approved by the Superintendent of Education and your local school board *before* you release your calendar to the public. Indiana law requires that students receive 180 days of instruction. Staff development / in-service days, registration days, and school social events may not be counted as school days. Sunday field trips may be counted as school days if specific criteria are met, please check with the Superintendent of Education for information regarding the criteria.
