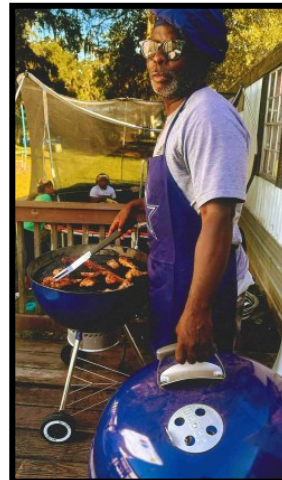
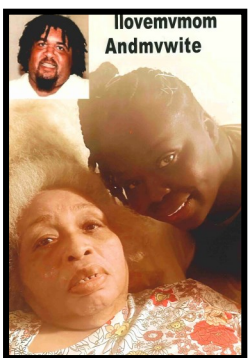
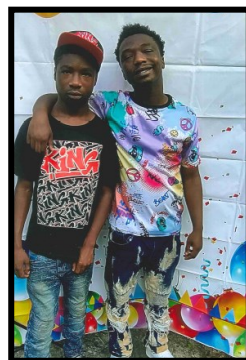
# Obituary
