We will begin worshipping together again in our church on **Sabbath, June 6!**


We will maintain social distancing with no handshaking or hugging and lots of hand washing and hand sanitizing. We will have several face coverings available for those who need them.


We Have Groceries! We Can Help!

Reminder from the CDC
