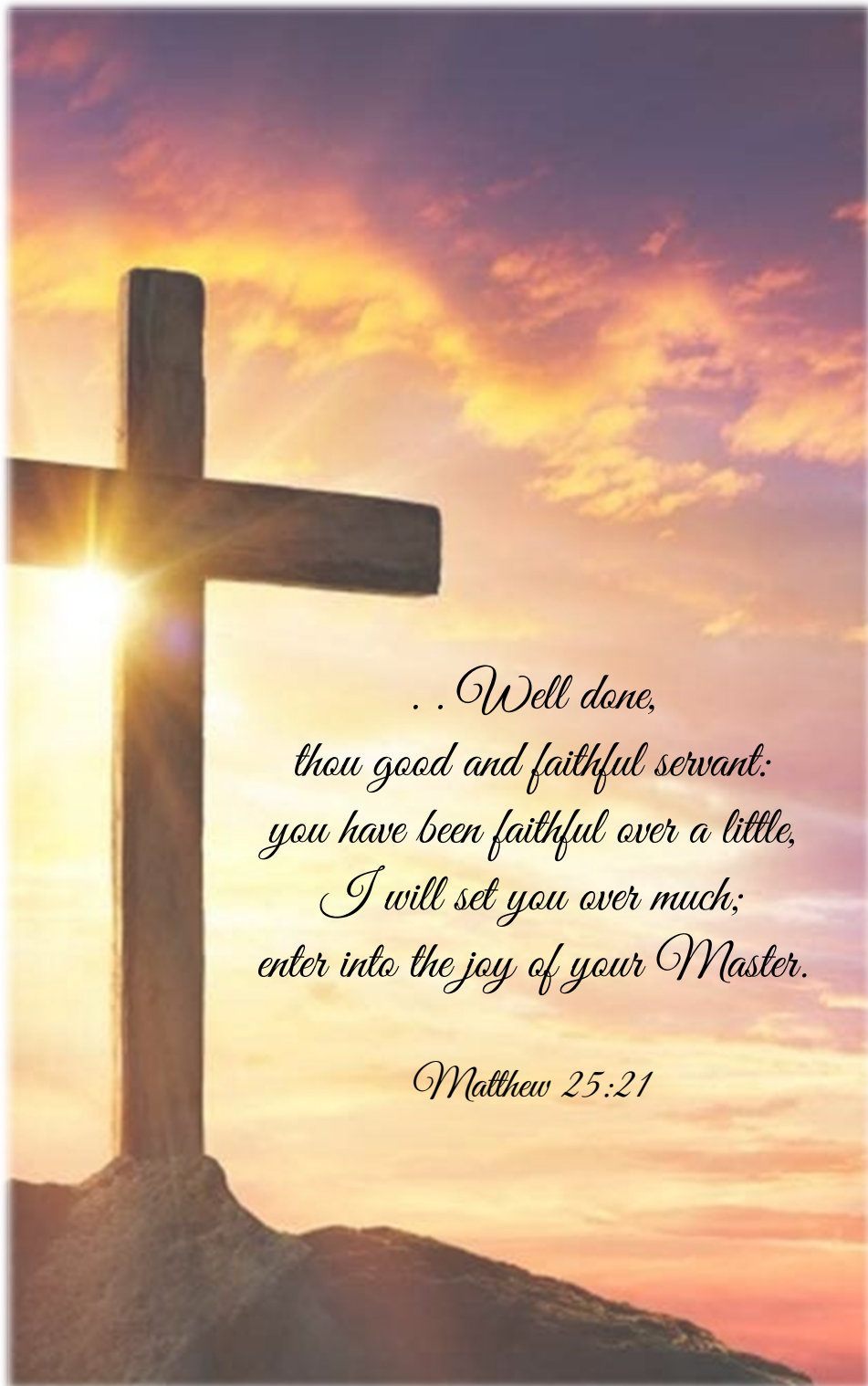
Lois was caring and thoughtful and will be missed by so many.
