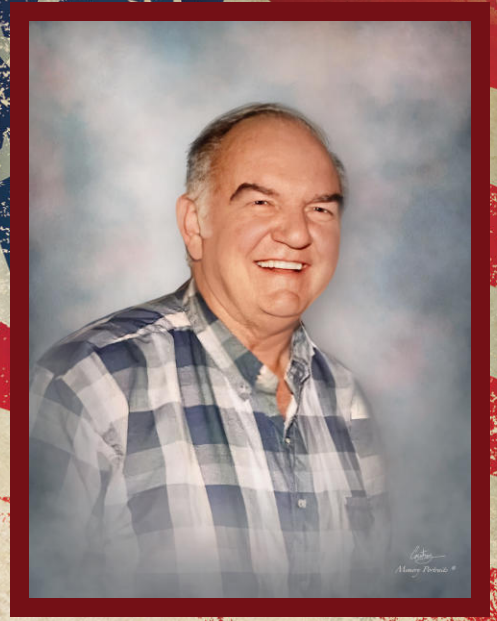
We appreciate you coming out today to celebrate a very important man. Thank you for your outpouring of love, prayers, and support during this time in our life.
