Jerry L. Grisham, Jr., 47, passed away unexpectedly but peacefully on September 20, 2024.

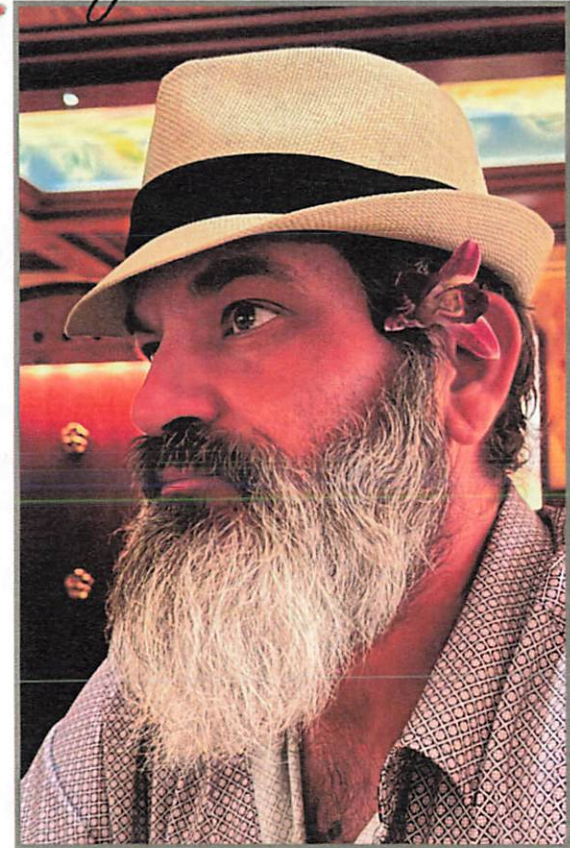
