Pastor's Note

INCREDIBLE GENEROSITY

For decades various universities, hospitals, and other charitable organizations had received huge financial gifts—as high as \$30 million to one recipient—from an anonymous donor. The gifts came in cashier's checks so that the recipient could not trace the source. But in 1997 this secret giver was forced to reveal himself when he sold his company, and a lawsuit over the sale disclosed his anonymous donations.

His name is Charles F. Feeney, one of the cofounders of a company called Duty Free Shoppes, which sells luxury items in airports and in the mid-nineties had sales of more than \$3 billion annually. According to writer Judith Miller in the New York Times, over a fifteen-year period Feeney's two charitable foundations gave away some \$600 million, leaving himself some \$5 million. In 1997 the proceeds from the sale of Duty Free Shoppes and other business assets—some \$3.5 billion—also went into Feeney's charitable institutions.

Mr. Feeney reluctantly explained his generosity. "I simply decided that I had enough money," he said. "It doesn't drive my life. I'm a what-you-get kind of guy."

Indeed, the lawyer who advised him in the setting up of his charitable foundations said, "He doesn't own a house. He doesn't own a car. He flies economy. And I think his watch cost about \$15." (From Craig Brian Larson and Leadership Journal)
