thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

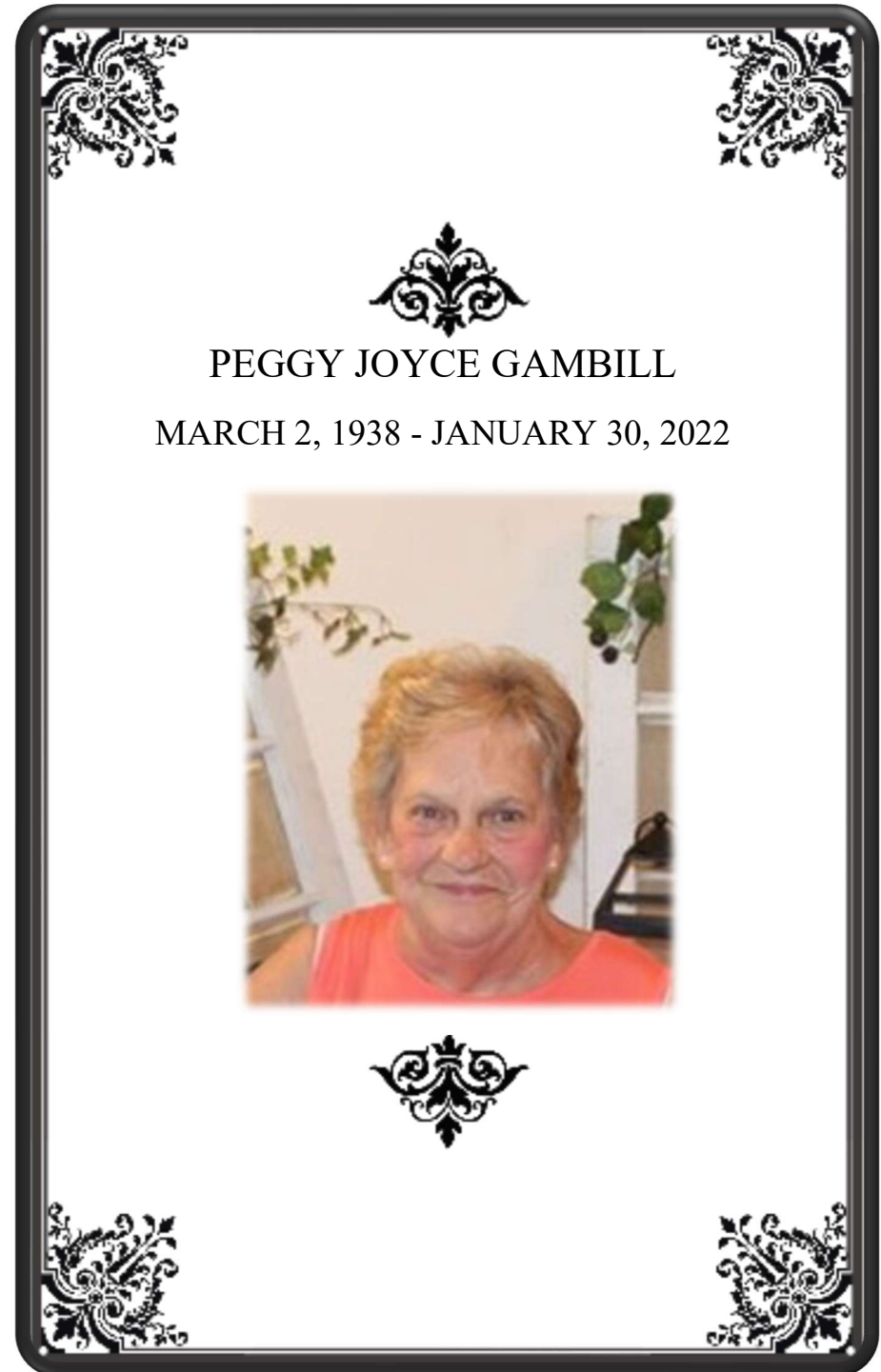
Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies:
