Pastor's Note

BE EXCEPTIONAL

On Tuesday, April 18, 1995, superstar Joe Montana announced his retirement from pro football after sixteen seasons. To salute him, twenty thousand residents of San Francisco filled the downtown area for a ceremony in Montana's honor.

Television announcer John Madden came to the podium and gave his opinion of Montana's skills: "This is the greatest quarterback who's ever played the game."

At one point in the ceremonies when Bill Walsh, Montana's longtime coach at the 49ers, was at the microphone, a fan yelled, "We love you, Joe."

Walsh knew that hadn't always been the case. "You weren't saying that in 1979," he replied to the fan. "Then you were saying, 'Where'd you get this guy who looks like a Swedish placekicker?'"

In 1979 Joe Montana was merely a third-round draft pick out of Notre Dame. Scouts said he had a weak arm. He was skinny. He lacked the muscular build of most football players.

But when Joe Montana stepped into the pros, he entered his element. He threw passes with perfect timing. He was the master of the two-minute drill. He went on to win four Super Bowls, helping turn the derelict 49ers into the dominant team of the 1980s.

Joe Montana was at first unimpressive to many people but was destined to be the greatest. In an infinite way, those words also describe Jesus Christ. (From Craig Brian Larson and Leadership Journal)
