- 🌿 **Our Church’s Covid-19 Policy to Keep Everyone Safe:**
 - Do your best to maintain a 6-foot distance from others.

 - Use sanitizing wipes on high-touch areas in restrooms.
 - **FACE-COVERING POLICY:** Worshipers are asked to wear one *at all times* unless you have a medical exemption or are under 5 years old.
 - Please wear a mask *while singing* as well (exceptions are behind Plexiglas or a soloist).
 - A speaker may walk about the platform without a mask at a 15’ distance.
 - We ask you to wear one not from fear, but in consideration for some who are deeply concerned, for the health of others, and to follow the temporary state health department requirements.
 - The rationale for this policy is based on: 1 Peter 2:13-17; Romans 13:1-7; Counsels for the Church, pages 314-315.
 - Please be considerate and respectful of those who may not be wearing a mask.
 - Our heartfelt desire is that everyone feel welcome and loved as we worship God together.

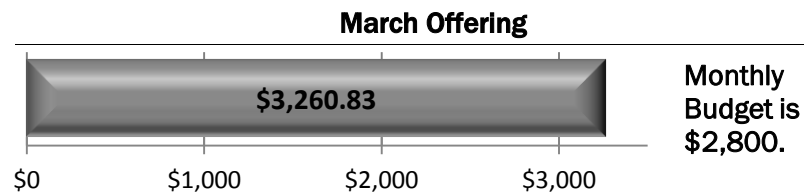
