Laverne Lois Peterson was born August 3, 1924, in Fergus Falls to Herbert and Alma (Stein) Schoening. She was an only child.

Her mother died when she was 9 years old. She was baptized and confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church, rural Fergus Falls. She attended rural school district #80 and the old Washington Junior High School in Fergus Falls. Later on, she attended the Hairdressing Academy in Fargo. She received her beautician license and worked in a beauty shop in Fergus Falls before her marriage, on October 12, 1946, she married James Peterson at Immanuel Lutheran Church and moved to Ashby and became a farm wife and homemaker.
