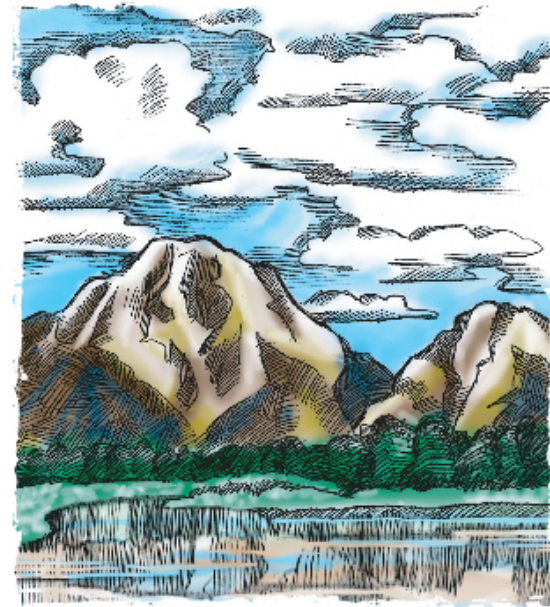

Potluck Lunch Update

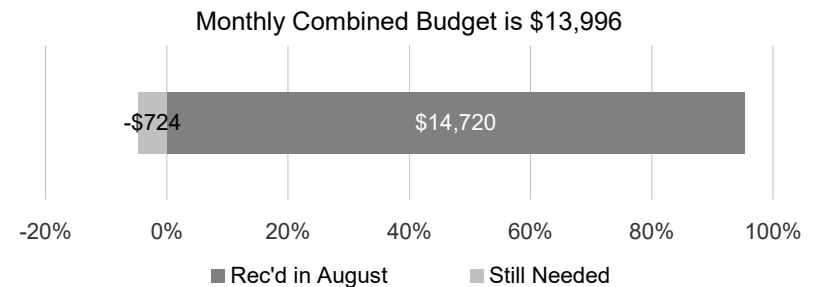
