As a farm kid in rural Wisconsin, Gene knew how to entertain himself with the finer things in life, like making fancy paper airplanes and origami birds, making whistles from blades of grass, yo-yo tricks, etc. He very much enjoyed sharing these pastimes with his children and grandchildren. He was a huge Green Bay Packer fan all his life, and later followed the Minnesota Twins closely.


