and Grace will lead us home.*

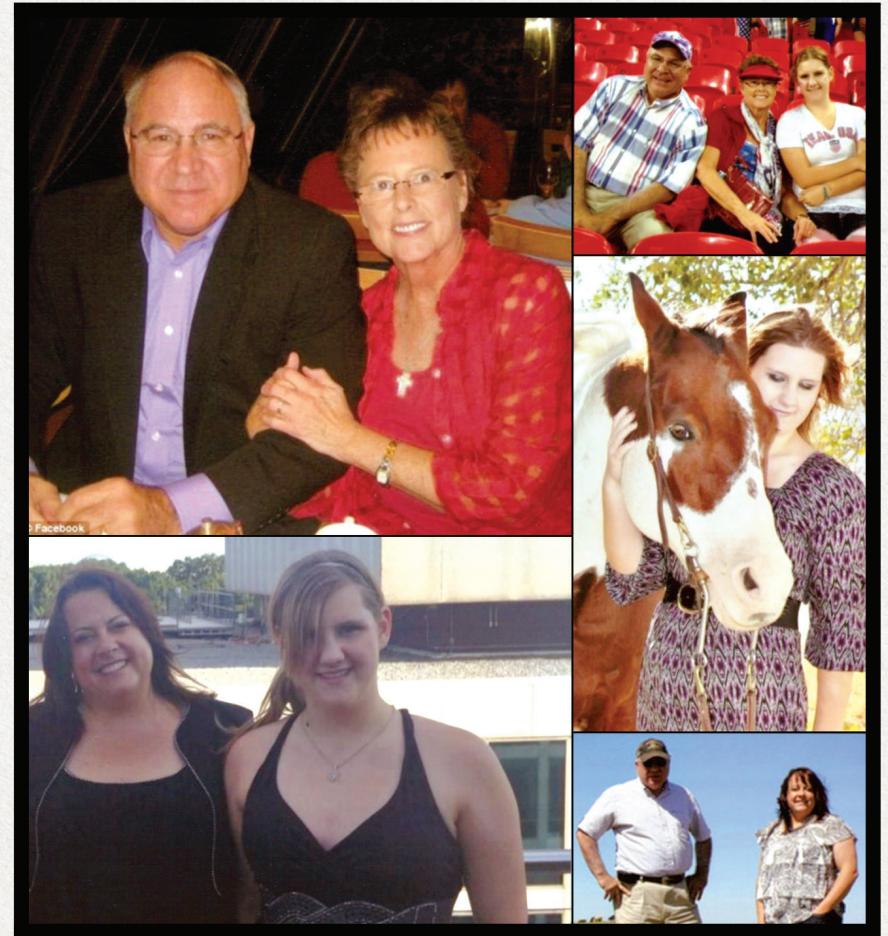
*Yea, when this flesh and heart shall fail,
