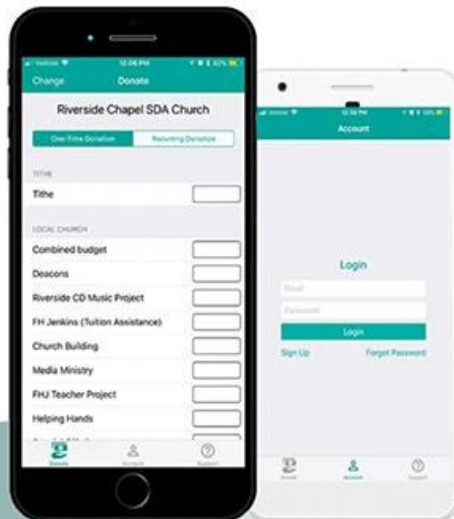

I've been pondering what it means to be strong. I've always pictured muscles and a set jaw and no crying. I've also thought of perfection and letting no weakness or flaws show.
