Australian Rules of Racquetball - Summary

- Scoring – please refer to your applicable draw for the scoring system that applies to your grade.
- Service – there will be two service attempts in all matches.
- Doubles Service – at the beginning of each game the serving team shall decide which player is to serve, thereafter alternating with their partner at the beginning of each game. In the third game (if required) players are to switch service once either team reaches 11 points.
- Doubles Service – the server's partner must have both feet entirely within the service box on the opposite side to the receiver until the server strikes the ball.
- The following shots are not permitted in Doubles:
 - Striking the ball between the striker's legs
 - Striking the ball behind the striker's back
 - Any "three wall/corkscrew" shot – regardless of whether the ball hits the third wall on the full.
- Players are allowed to play off the back wall (without turning).
- Players are allowed to strike the ball after allowing it to pass behind their body (as long as they do not physically turn)

Tournament Conditions

- Players should arrive at the centre at least 30 mins prior to their match and are expected to mark and/or referee the match following their own (unless otherwise instructed by the Tournament Director).
- Matches will be played under the Australian Rules of Racquetball (subject to these by-laws)
- Presentations for the Singles events will be held after the completion of matches on Saturday, and after the completion of matches on Sunday for the Doubles.
- Food and drinks will be available for purchase at the café throughout the day
