

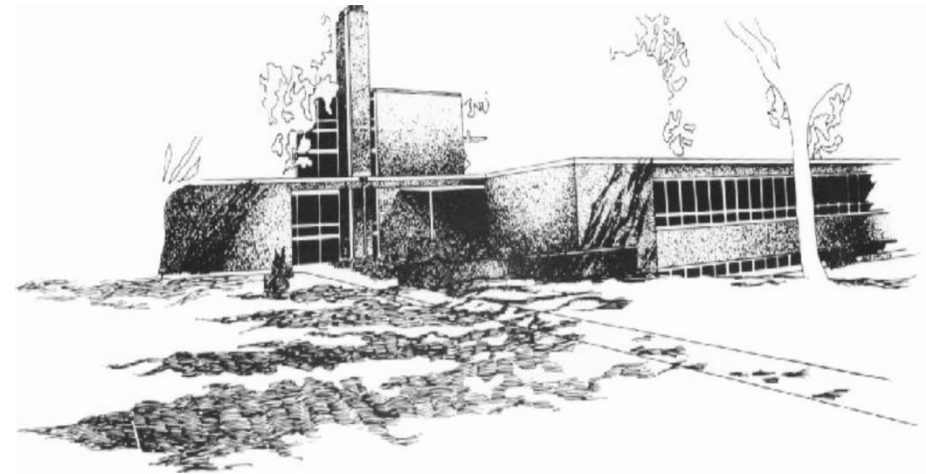
Generations in Ministry

The package cooks up like a rice casserole. When cooked longer and softer it can be like a creamed cereal for the babies and those with few teeth...for a regular meal it can be served alone or with whatever foods people can add. It is a complete protein meal. KAH serves populations in the USA and overseas. Clipboards will be passed on February 13 for volunteers to sign up. More information soon.

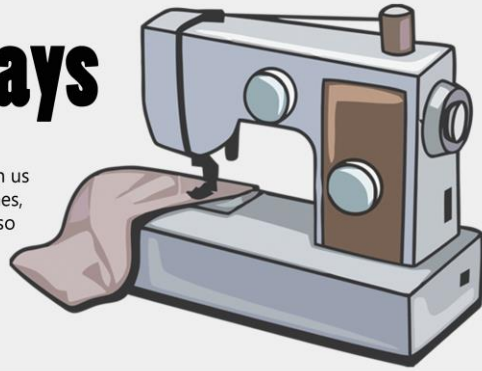
