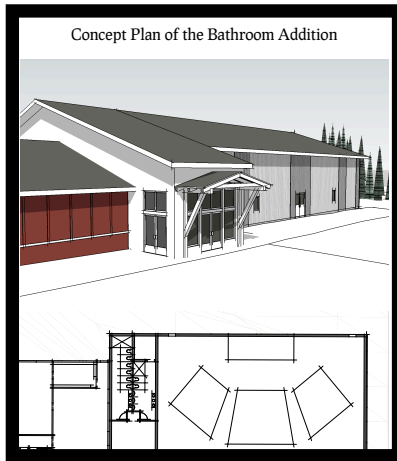


Food for Thought
