His Story

James Clinton Albert was born in the Love County Community of Ran, January 4, 1943. He was the second of 8 children born to Vernie (Clayton) Albert and Judge Albert. A resident of Love County most of his life, he attended Marietta and Douglass High Schools. He was drafted and later enlisted in the U.S. Army and served two terms in Viet Nam. Afterwards, he joined the United States Navy and again served in Viet Nam. James was a chef, and cooked for many restaurants while in the Service, and throughout Carter County.
