Lane grew up early when his parents passed during his teenage years. He then worked several farm jobs until enlisting in the Army. Near the end of the Korean War conflict, he proudly served as a crane operator and was also stationed on Iwo Jima. On December 19, 1956, he married Kathleen Holtz. After a long honeymoon touring the country in their '56 Chevy, he worked for Lyon County ASCS for 20 years. Lane founded L&M Home Imp. And enjoyed success as a salesman. For several years afterwards, he drove

school bus for West Lyon and became one of the Wildcats' biggest fans, especially bonding with the football/softball athletes and coaches.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing, hobby farming, puzzles, pinochle, and most of all loved spending time with his family. Lane cherished all the good times with his family and friends and was quoted "For what I went through, I don't know how I ended up with such a good family" and "I have the BEST kids."
