I leave you with the sunshine of tomorrow.*

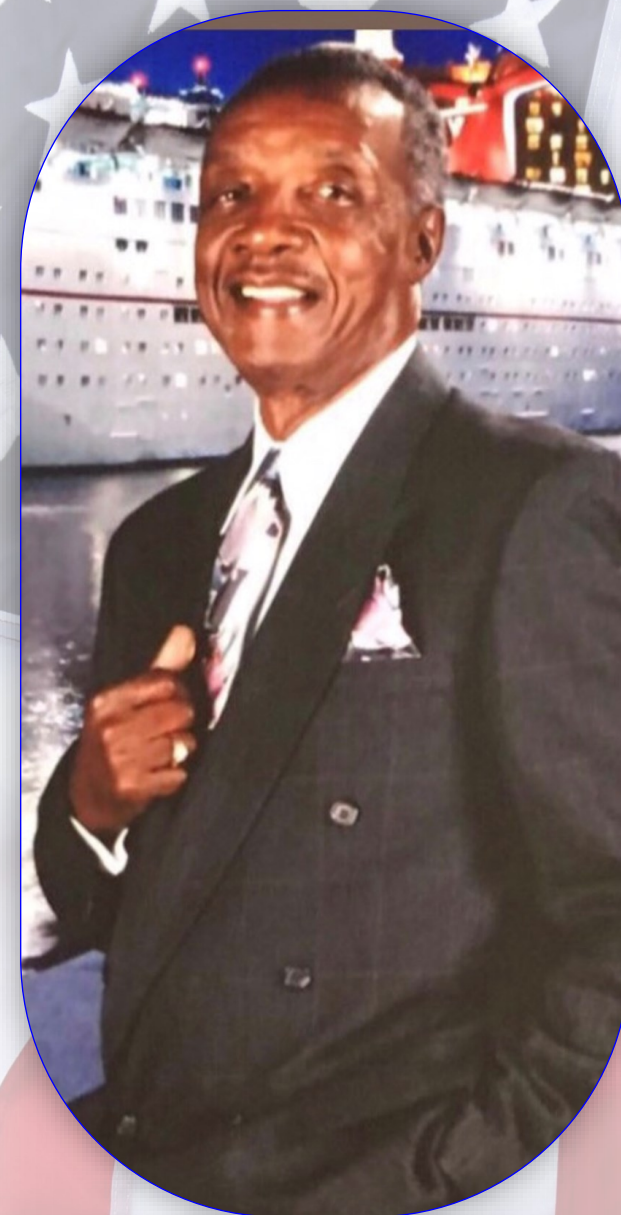
