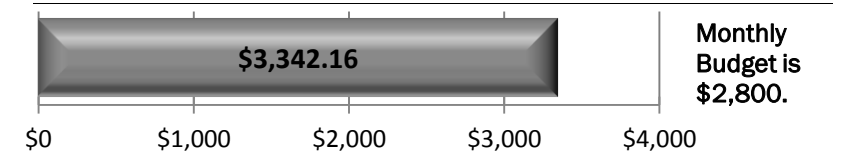
Church Financial Summary
