Introductory Rites

A conscious connection is made with the BAPTISM experience of Bill. The WATER reminds us of the decision and the promise of everlasting life made at Baptism. Now we stand proudly with him to claim the fullness of that promise. The Paschal (Easter) Candle is a silent symbol of the presence of the Risen Christ. INCENSE is used as a gentle way of honoring Bill. It is also a visual symbol of how our prayer rises to heaven and how we send our beloved to God in heaven.
